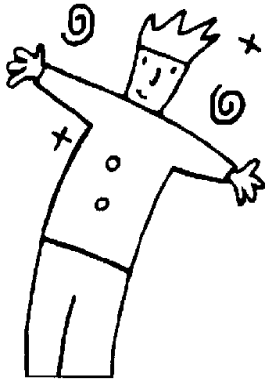
Happy New Year!
