## THE THEODORE PARKER SCHOLARSHIP

The TED PARKER SCHOLARSHIP (Theodore Phifer Parker) was established in 1996 by Ted's parents, Mr. and Mrs. Albert P. Parker, to honor his memory. Ted is remembered fondly by his friends and co-workers at Wright Patterson Air Force Base former Area B Travel Division and others who knew him.

One \$1,500 scholarship is being offered for the 2008-2009 academic year. The award is to be used to provide assistance in attaining undergraduate and graduate degrees in Government or Public Service at Wright State University, The University of Dayton, Central State University or Wilberforce University. Assistance will be for tuition and related educational expenses. Applicant may attend full or part-time.

To be eligible for consideration, applicants must:

- Provide evidence of current enrollment at Wright State University, The University of Dayton, Central State University, or Wilberforce University.
- Be a sophomore or junior who will have earned sufficient credit hours to be classified as a junior or senior in the upcoming fall or a graduate student
- Have a 3.0 cumulative grade point average on a scale of 4.0 points
- Be a Government or Public Service major as defined by the college/university the applicant is attending
- **Submit a completed application form accompanied by the following:**
  - A copy of your most recent grade transcript
  - A recent letter of recommendation from a teacher, coach, employer or advisor
  - A brief essay describing your educational/career goals (approximately one page, double-spaced)
  - A copy of the letter and summary page from the Student Aid Report (SAR) from the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
  - If applicable, an explanation of financial support for your higher education provided by a non-custodial parent or a stepparent

Criteria for selection include: academic performance, financial need, participation in school and community activities, recommendation and essay.

The Dayton Foundation will appoint a Selection Committee. The Committee may elect not to award a scholarship if, in its judgment, a suitable candidate cannot be identified.
