MINOR IN BIOLOGICAL SCIENCES**

Students majoring in another department may earn a Minor in Biological Sciences. The Minor program includes at least 36 credit hours from a broad selection of courses in Biological Sciences (BIO), Microbiology & Immunology (M&I) and Exercise Biology (EXB).

Minimum Entry Requirements:

- 24 hours of previous university coursework (or equivalent) with grades of C or better
- An overall 2.25 grade point average in the introductory biology courses (BIO 111, 112, 115)

II. LIFE SCIENCE ELECTIVES (22 cr. hrs)

Select 22 credits from approved BIO, EXB or M&I electives

- BIO 200 to 499 (*a maximum of 5 credit hours of independent study [BIO 399, 495, 488, 492 or 499] may be applied*)
- EXB 200 to 499
- M&I 200 to 499
- Approved courses by the Department

TOTAL CREDIT HOURS REQUIRED: 36

* All BIO, EXB and M&I courses must be a grade of C or better for graduation credit

* Other courses outside the Biology Department *may* be considered for approval

* You must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 to graduate
