

## Configuring iPhone or iPod Touch for the WSU Network



## Connecting to the WSU Wireless Network

Connecting to the WSU Wireless Network (Wi-Fi) is easy. If you are on campus, you can simply open safari and attempt to go to a web page. If your iPhone/iPod Touch hasn't already connected to a wireless network, you will automatically be prompted to connect via "WSU Wireless."

If your device doesn't automatically connect to WSU Wireless Wi-Fi, connect manually:

Go to Settings > Wi-Fi > Choose a Network... > WSU Wireless

Click the wireless network with the strongest signal

Once connected, go to safari and go to any web page

Authenticate with your username and password

It is important to remember that iPhones typically use the Edge (cellular) network to connect to the internet if it is out of range of Wi-Fi. If you have disabled the feature to automatically find wireless networks, you must connect manually.

## Configuring Email

The iPhone and iPod Touch (iPod Touch software version 1.1.4 or greater) have an email client that allows users to check their email on the go. Setting up email is fairly simple; just follow these instructions.

**Important:** if you are connected through Wi-Fi (the WSU wireless network), be sure to open Safari and go to any web page. You will be prompted to authenticate and must do this before setting up your account.

If this is the first account you're setting up on iPhone or iPod touch, tap Mail. Otherwise, from the Home screen choose Settings > Mail > Accounts > Add Account.

Choose your email account type: For WSU Mail choose Other.

Enter your account information:

Click **Other** and select a server type **IMAP** and enter your account information.

Your name: type your full name as you wish it to appear to mail recipients

Your email address: i.e. john.smith@wright.edu

The email server type: (IMAP)

The Internet host name for your incoming mail server: mail.wright.edu

The Internet host name for your outgoing mail server:mail.wright.edu

Your username and password for incoming and outgoing servers:your username is something like "w123abc" and the password is your WINGS/Novell password.

Be sure to enter the Host Name, User Name, and Password identically for each field.

## Setting up SSL (Required)

iPhone and iPod Touch email clients have to use SSL encryption to communicate with the WSU Mail server.

After setting up your email account, go to Settings > Mail >Your WSU Email Account

From the account setting menu, scroll all the way down to the bottom of the page and click **Advanced**

For both "Incoming Settings" and "Outgoing Settings" you must click the switch to turn Use SSL to **ON**

Be sure that the Incoming Settings Server Port changes to **993**

Be sure that the Outgoing Settings Server Port changes to **465**

## Changing your Signature Block

By default the signature for your device will say, "Sent from my iPhone/iPod." If you want to change your signature to have your contact info

Go to Settings > Mail >Signature

Delete the current signature and enter your contact info or whatever closing information you wish to provide with each email you send

Touch the mail arrow on the top left when you are finished and the signature will be updated
