

Software and Hardware Device Exception Disclaimer

The purpose of this agreement is to clearly define requirements for owners of software and hardware devices that fall outside of Computing and Telecommunications Services (CaTS) recommendations.

I accept maintenance and security responsibility of all devices listed below.

If there is a reasonable suspicion that a device is a potential liability to the WSU network (security vulnerability, causing problems with internal or external WSU network, unauthorized access to private network or WSU network, or hampering users on the WSU network), access to the network may be terminated or be restricted from certain network access. In cases where university network resources and privileges are threatened by improperly maintained devices, CaTS will attempt to work with the relevant device owner to quickly close security holes. In circumstances where these collaborative efforts fail or there is an urgent situation requiring immediate action and leaving no time for collaboration, the device may be disconnected from the network.
