

# Individual Item Response

---

The Individual Item Response report shows student responses for a subtest or total test. The following data appears in the body of the report:

❶ **Question Number** is a line of numbers indicating the question numbers for the test or subtest.

❷ **Answer Key** lists the correct answers for the test according to these rules:

- When any response is correct, an asterisk (\*) is shown.
- When all responses are to be ignored, a space is shown.
- When there is only one possible correct answer (normal test question), the answer is indicated by a number from 1 thru 5 for 5-response tests and 0 thru 9 for 10-response tests (“0” represents “10”).

The lines are labeled (1), (51), (101), and so on. The number of lines shown depends on the number of test questions printed on the answer sheet. For example, a 60-question test will show two lines of answer key items. Q# is the same information for respondent answers.

❸ **Identification #** is the ID of the student taking the test as entered in the **Identification #** field of the Student Answer sheet.

❹ **Name** is the name of the person taking the test as entered in the Student Answer sheet. You can choose to omit student names from the report by selecting the **Omit Student Names** option in the **Reports Selection** screen.

❺ **Score** is the raw score for the subtest or total test. If Weighted scoring or Formula scoring are used, the raw score is calculated accordingly.

❻ **Item Responses** are the answers selected by the student according to these rules:

- 1 thru 5 identifies a wrong answer on a 5-response test; 0 thru 9 identifies a wrong answer for a 10-response test (“0” represents “10”).
- Correct answers are identified with a period (.)
- Questions not answered (omits) are identified with a dash (-).
- Multiple answers are identified with an asterisk (\*).
- A blank ( ) identifies questions not scored (as specified on answer key).

The following summary information is printed at the bottom of this report.

❶ **Key Symbols** identify the symbols used in the answer key.

❷ **Respondent Symbols** identify the symbols (\*,-, etc.) used for respondent answers.

❸ **Number of Respondents** is the number of respondents included in the report.

❹ **Average/Median Score** are the mean score and median score for the reported group.

❺ **Highest/Lowest Score** are the highest and lowest scores for the reported group.

❻ **Standard Deviation** is the range above or below the average score where the majority of the scores lie.
