

Individual Test Results

The main body of the Individual Test Results report contains the following items.

- 1 Student ID is the ID of the respondent as entered on the answer sheet, however, the first 4 digits have been omitted to protect student privacy should this report be posted. Please keep in mind that it is against Registrar's policy to post student grades in an open area.
- 2 Mastery is the number of points required for the mastery of the test or subtest. This optional value is entered on the Answer Key sheet. If no Mastery is required; the key is simple filled in as "0". If the mastery is not defined the line will be blank. If mastery is defined, students that have mastered the exam will have an "*" next to their score. You may request reports that show only those who mastered the exam and/or only those that did not.
- 3 Raw Score is the total number of points achieved for each subtest and the overall test. Mastery, if selected, is indicated by an "*". If formula scoring is used, the raw score is calculated accordingly.

The following summary information is printed at the bottom of each page of the report.

- 4 Number of Respondents is the number of persons included in the report.
- 5 Number of Items is the total number of questions in the test. This value should match the first entry under the Total column in the report body.
- 6 Average Score is the average score (mean) for the reported group.
- 7 Median Score is the median score for the reported group.
- 8 Std. Deviation is the range above or below the average score where the majority of the scores lie.
- 9 Highest Score is the highest score for the reported group.
- 10 Lowest Score is the lowest score for the reported group.
- 11 The subtest legend displays each subtest number and name. If mastery is selected, this includes the number and percent of students who mastered each subtest.
