Financial Assistance for Graduate Students

Tuition Scholarships

Tuition scholarships may be awarded for any quarter to persons who are interested in studying at Wright State University and who qualify for admission to the graduate program in English. Only first time graduate students are eligible for tuition scholarships. These scholarships are competitive. Applications are reviewed by the Graduate Studies Committee in the Department of English.

Benefits

Full tuition waivers for up to two years of course work. After completing the first three quarters of study, tuition waivers include the summer quarters.

Requirements

Scholarships are awarded only to students who have never registered for graduate coursework at Wright State University.

Recipients must maintain a B average in course work.

Recipients are required to take a minimum of three courses--12 credit hours--during the regular academic year (fall, winter, and spring quarters). Recipients may take less than twelve credit hours during the summer quarter.
