THE HELP ROOM IS A PLACE WHERE STT 160 STUDENTS CAN GO TO GET ASSISTANCE WITH HOMEWORK, TEST PREP, LISTS OF SUPPLEMENTAL PROBLEMS, AND ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS THAT CAME UP DURING LECTURE.

How it Works:

The first thing you should do when you go to the help room is sign in! There will be an attendance sheet, and your STT 160 teacher will decide whether or not going to the help room will benefit your course grade. Your teacher will have a folder in the help room with any important information that the student workers need. **THERE WILL BE WORKSHEETS FOR EXTRA PRACTICE LOCATED IN THE HELP ROOM.**

There will be a student helper in the help room during the times and locations below who has recently taken STT 160. She will be able to answer your questions and assist you with issues regarding homework, lecture, test prep, additional practice problems, etc. She CANNOT help you complete problems on take-home quizzes, tests, or assignments due for credit in your class, and she will not give a lecture, but she can answer general questions or similar exercises related to problems of that nature. You are welcome to work with other students in the help room, and there will be a student solution manual there for reference. There is no charge to go to the help room, and it is meant to be a supportive environment where you can get the help you need in order to do your best in the course.
