QUIZZES: There are five (5) homework problems in each assignment which are underlined and bold-faced. These homework problems should be written up separately from the rest of your homework. Your instructor may choose to collect these problems instead of giving a quiz; your score on these problems will count as the quiz grade. There will be 12 ten (10) point quizzes that will come directly from the homework assignments. You may drop your 2 lowest quiz grades.

TESTS: ALL sections of MTH 126 take machine scored multiple choice tests prepared by the mathematics department. The evening section of MTH 126 has 3, 50 minute tests. **IN ORDER TO BE ALLOWED TO MAKE UP A MISSED TEST YOU MUST:**
