So you spent a week learning about CMP2 and using it in your classroom. Now what!?! This yearlong follow-up to your summer training allows you to continue working with our knowledgeable presenters and other area teachers who are using CMP2 everyday in their classroom. Get support with the issues of actually implementing CMP2 in your classroom: How to assign, assess, and evaluate ACE problems, how to have students work effectively in groups, how to help students organize their work, how to use assessment and other materials that come with CMP2, and how to help students understand the mathematics you want them to learn.

Activities for this institute may include observing, reflecting, and discussing classroom video of other teachers using CMP2, attending other teachers’ classrooms that are implementing CMP2 materials, work with others to develop a pacing guide for specific units and your classroom/school/district, using the assessment CD to develop end of unit assessments and other assessments that meet the needs of your students, and other activities that will support you in implementing CMP2 in the spirit in which these materials were created.

You will receive the student and teacher edition books for your grade level, those that were not provided during the summer training. In addition, since this institute is funded by a Math-Science Partnership grant (MSP) at Wright State, you also receive a stipend for participating.

Who may attend: Teachers who participated in CMP professional development institutes through WeEXCEL in summer 2007 or summer 2008.
