

# Understanding and Using Connected Mathematics

Where: Wright State University

Who should attend: Teachers using CMP2 for less than 2 years and/or have not attended previous CMP training at WSU or Michigan State  
Teachers or curriculum specialists considering adopting CMP2  
Note that teachers participating in CMP summer professional development for the first time are required to also attend the CMP follow-up during the academic year
