

Estimating Anthem Discounted Costs for Prescription Drugs and Other Healthcare Expenses Under the Anthem High Deductible Health Plan

To Estimate the Anthem Discounted Costs for Prescription Drugs for the Anthem HDHP

Go to www.anthem.com.

Click on the Member Login button and input the Username of demo_hsa6

and the password of anthem001.

Under My Anthem click on the link to My Pharmacy.

Under Pharmacy Tools click on the link to Look Up Drug Prices.

Input the requested information about the drug to be purchased and the quantity needed (a maximum of a 30-day supply for a non-mail order medication and a 30-90 day supply for a mail order medication).

The information you receive should show you the estimated cost of the medication after the Anthem-negotiated discount for no more than a 30-day supply of a medication from a network retail pharmacy (CVS, K-Mart, WSU pharmacy, etc.) and the estimated cost of the drug using Anthem's network mail order pharmacy in Mason, Ohio for a 30-90 day supply.

To estimate the cost of Other Medical expenses under the High Deductible Health Plan Using Your Past Anthem Medical Claims History

Go to www.anthem.com.

Click on the Member Login button and login using your personal User Name and password (Go through the registration process to get these if you do not already have them.)

Agree to the MyAnthem Online Access Agreement.

On the MyAnthem home page click on the My Claims tab.

Select the two year period for which you are seeking claim detail and input these dates.

The information you receive should show the estimated discounted cost for which services were received and Anthem claims were filed in the two year period you select. The estimated discounted cost of a covered service will be the sum of any payment that Anthem made to the provider of the service plus any copayment/coinsurance share of the cost paid by the employee or covered dependent (e.g. \$53.42 paid by Anthem + the employee's \$20 office visit copay = \$73.42 the discounted cost for an office visit with an undiscounted charge of \$100).
