I. JOB INFORMATION

Job Title: Building & Grounds Maint. Supervisor/LC (CS 06)

Job Class: 41121 FLSA Status: Non-Exempt

II. JOB SUMMARY

Under administrative direction provides support, supervision and direction to the work force to include specific activities relating to maintenance function.

III. PRIMARY DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Plans, assigns and supervises completion of work for maintenance, grounds and custodial crews. Supervises and participates with crews engaged in a variety of buildings, grounds maintenance and custodial activities.
- Maintains all required logs and files including, but not limited to, work orders within the ISIS system, overtime rosters, purchases, maintenance projects, and inventory.
- Responsible for budget controls and approves expenditures within authority limits. Maintains accurate budget records and logs following purchasing processes and policies and manages inventory of parts and materials for efficient work processes.
- Communicates concerns and responds to emergencies including structural, mechanical and electrical systems including safety systems such as fire and smoke alarms, elevators and emergency generators to ensure safe and efficient operations.

IV. MINIMUM EDUCATION, EXPERIENCE, KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES

A bachelor's degree and one year of (FT) related work experience OR a two year post-secondary education and three years of (FT) related work experience OR, a high school diploma and over five years of (FT) related work experience. Direct supervisory experience; extensive knowledge of skilled and semi-skilled trades; management experience, priority setting and customer service skills; high degree of technical, mechanical and electrical knowledge; project management experience. Extensive knowledge of the Ohio Revised Code, Ohio Fire Code and Ohio Basic Building Codes and ability to calculate basic math.

V. WORKING CONDITIONS

May be required to work weekends and nights when necessary and to carry paging or cellular equipment for normal business activities and after normal working hour's response. Conditions may require walking, stooping, pushing, pulling, lifting (less than or equal to 40 pounds), bending, handling equipment and materials. May be required to work on holidays.
