For 2010 High School Graduates Who Attend the Lake Campus

Application Deadline: March 1, 2010

Distribution Policy & Procedure

Recipients must register for classes offered at the Lake Campus. Registration must be completed by the first day of the quarter. Most scholarships will not be disbursed unless the recipient has registered at least twelve (12) or more credit hours per quarter.

The award amount will be divided equally and applied toward the recipient's fall, winter, and spring quarter fees. Should a recipient be unable to attend any one of these quarters, he/she may petition in writing to request to use a one-quarter disbursement during the summer quarter of the award year. If a recipient is graduating mid-year of the academic year, he/she may petition in writing to request that the total award be divided equally over his/her remaining quarter(s). All letters of petition should be sent to the Scholarship Coordinator, WOEF-LC Scholarships, 104 Dwyer Hall, 7600 Lake Campus Drive, Celina, Ohio 45822 and received prior to the 15th day of August of the award year.

Recipients must maintain the academic standards of their intended major and/or scholarship sponsor. If a recipient does not maintain the required academic standards, he/she can be placed on scholastic probation and future scholarship disbursements withheld.

A recipient placed on probation must show continuous academic improvement to receive future distributions. To be removed from scholastic probation, the recipient must attain the required grade point average (GPA). Recipients placed on probation will be ineligible to receive any other Lake Campus scholarship for one (1) year after the scholastic probation period ends.

Scholarship Guidelines

The combined totals of Western Ohio Educational Foundation (WOEF) scholarship assistance may not exceed the total cost of tuition.

All Wright State University grade point averages (GPA) are based on a 4.0 grading system.

Scholarships are awarded on an "as funds are available" basis.

Required application materials sent by USPS must be postmarked by the *Application Deadline* to be considered.

Applicants must apply for admission to Wright State University as a degree-seeking student and submit all transcripts and test scores prior to the *Application Deadline*.

The University and the Foundation reserve the right to cancel a scholarship award if a recipient is found guilty of academic dishonesty.

Entering Freshmen Scholarships

The following scholarship opportunities are intended for Lake Campus entering freshmen only. Most awards require a minimum registration of at least twelve (12) or more credit hours at the Lake Campus of Wright State University unless noted otherwise. Scholarships will be awarded to applicants who meet the individual scholarship's criteria and who have the highest overall judges' rating within each award category.

The Crown Scholarship – Full Tuition, Renewable Up To 3 Years (2)

- (1) Awarded to a 2010 New Bremen High School graduate who is ranked in the upper 50 percent of his/her class and who has pursued a college preparatory curriculum.
- (2) Awarded to a 2010 graduate from an Auglaize, Darke, Mercer, or Shelby County high school who ranks in the upper 50 percent of his/her class and who has pursued a college preparatory curriculum.

St. Marys Fraternal Order of Eagles, Aerie 767 - Full Tuition

Awarded to a 2010 St. Marys Memorial High School graduate who has pursued a college preparatory curriculum while achieving a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Pax Machine Works - \$3,000 1st Year, Renewable 2nd Year

Awarded to a 2010 graduate of a Mercer County high school or any 2010 high school graduate who is the son or daughter of a Pax Machine Works employee. The recipient will have pursued a college preparatory curriculum and achieved a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Wayne Trail Technologies Scholarship - \$3,000 1st Year, and \$1,000 2nd Year

Awarded to a 2010 graduate of a Shelby County high school or any 2010 high school graduate who is the son or daughter of a Wayne Trail Technologies employee. The recipient will have pursued a college preparatory curriculum and achieved a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Academic Excellence Scholarships - \$3,000 1st Year, and \$1,000 2nd Year (22)

Awarded to a 2010 graduate from each Auglaize, Mercer and Van Wert County high school and each of the following Allen and Darke County high schools: Delphos Jefferson, Delphos St. Johns, Spencerville, Ansonia, Greenville, Mississinawa Valley, and Versailles. Recipients must have a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or higher and rank in the upper 50 percent of their high school graduating class.

Stephen & Opal Jagoditz Scholarship – up to \$3,000 (various awards)

Awarded to entering, current, returning, or transfer students who reside in Auglaize County. Recipients selected according to their situational needs, work or volunteer experience and academic records.

Richard & Catharine Sharp Estate Scholarship – up to \$3,000 (various awards)

Awarded to entering, current, returning, or transfer students who reside in Mercer County. Recipients selected according to their situational needs, work or volunteer experience and academic records.

Reuben & Leola Wissman Scholarship – up to \$3,000 (various awards)

Awarded to entering, current, returning, or transfer students enrolled in an engineering program or engineering related activity. Recipients selected according to their situational needs, work or volunteer experience and academic records.

First Financial Bank Scholarship - \$2,500

Awarded to a 2010 graduate who resides in Auglaize, Mercer, Paulding, or Van Wert County. The recipient will have pursued a college preparatory curriculum and achieved a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Celina VFW, Post 5713 of Ohio Charities - \$2,500

Awarded to a Mercer County entering, current, returning, or transfer student who is an honorably discharged veteran, an immediate family member of a veteran, or the grandchild of a veteran. Minimum quarterly registration is eight (8) or more credit hours. Applicants must complete and submit a *Veteran's Status* form (Page 14)

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Precision Strip Scholarship - \$2,000

Awarded to a 2010 graduate of an Auglaize, Darke, Mercer, or Shelby County high school. The recipient will have pursued a college preparatory curriculum and achieved a cumulative high school GPA of 2.7 or higher. Recipient must be pursuing a degree in business or engineering. Recipient selected according to his/her situational needs, work or volunteer experience and academic records.

Rockford Fraternal Order of Eagles, Shane's Aerie 1292 - \$1,200 (3)

- (1) Awarded to a 2010 Parkway High School graduate who has pursued a college preparatory curriculum while achieving a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- (2) Awarded to a 2010 Parkway High School graduate who has pursued a college preparatory curriculum, has a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or higher, and who is or has a family member who is a member of the Rockford Eagles. If no Parkway senior qualifies, a Lake Campus continuing student who resides in the Parkway school district and who is or has a family member who is a member of the Rockford Eagles will be considered.
- (3) Awarded to a 2010 graduate from any high school who has pursued a college preparatory curriculum, has a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or higher, and who is or has a family member who is a member of the Rockford Eagles. If no senior qualifies, a Lake Campus continuing student who resides in the Parkway school district and who is or has a family member who is a member of the Rockford Eagles will be considered.

Fuhrwerk Family Scholarship - \$1,200

Awarded to an entering, current, returning, or transfer student who resides in Auglaize, Darke, Mercer or Van Wert County and has achieved a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher. Recipient selected according to his/her situational needs. Minimum quarterly registration is six (6) or more credit hours.

AAP Scholarship - \$1,000

Awarded to a 2010 graduate of St. Marys Memorial High School or to a 2010 graduating senior from any high school who is the son or daughter of an AAP employee. The recipient will have pursued a college preparatory curriculum and achieved a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Mercer Savings Bank - \$1,000

Awarded to a 2010 high school graduate from a Mercer, Auglaize or Darke County. The recipient will have pursued a college preparatory curriculum and achieved a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or higher.

Tech Prep Scholarship - \$1,000 (3)

Awarded to 2010 high school graduates who are currently enrolled in the Tech Prep program at the Apollo Career Center, Ohio Hi-Point Career Center, Lima Senior High School, Millstream Tech Center, Tri-Star Career Compact, Vantage Career Center, Upper Valley JVS at Piqua, or the Miami Valley Career Tech Center. Recipients must provide documentation of program completion by completing and submitting the *Tech Prep Verification* form (page 13).

Bernard & Marilyn Schroer & Family Scholarship - \$1,000

Awarded to a 2010 high school graduate who resides in Auglaize County. The recipient will have pursued a college preparatory curriculum and achieved a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or higher.

The FluidPower Assembly Scholarship - \$1,000

Awarded to a 2010 high school graduate who resides in the Lake Campus region. The recipient will have pursued a college preparatory curriculum.

Janet Orick Nursing Scholarship - \$1,000

Awarded to entering, current, returning, or transfer student who is pursuing a nursing or healthcare degree. Recipient selected according to his/her situational needs and academic records.

Trustees General Scholarship - \$750

Awarded to entering, current, returning, or transfer students. Recipients selected according to their situational needs and academic records.

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Donald Krischak Memorial Scholarship – \$750

Awarded to entering, current, returning, or transfer students who are in good standing at their current school. Recipients selected according to their situational needs, work or volunteer experience and school or community activities.

Raymond & Patricia Giesige Memorial Scholarship – \$750

Awarded to entering, current, returning, or transfer students who are in good standing at their current school. Recipients selected according to their situational needs, work or volunteer experience and school or community activities.

First National Bank of New Bremen Scholarship - \$500

Awarded a 2010 high school graduate who resides in Auglaize, Mercer or Shelby County. The recipient will have pursued a college preparatory curriculum and achieved a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or higher.

STEM Scholarship - \$500

Awarded to a 2010 graduate from a Ft. Recovery, New Bremen or St. Henry high school who has pursued a college preparatory curriculum, earned a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or higher and will pursue a degree in science or engineering.

2 + 2 Organizational Leadership Bachelor Completion Program Scholarship - \$500

Awarded to entering, current, returning, or transfer students who are pursuing a bachelor degree in Organizational Leadership (OL). Recipients selected based upon their academic records, situational needs, work or volunteer experience and school or community activities. Minimum quarterly registration is six (6) or more credit hours.

BSN Completion Program Scholarship - \$500

Awarded to entering, current, returning, or transfer students who are pursuing a bachelor degree in the nursing completion program. Recipients selected according to their academic records, situational needs, work or volunteer experience, college or community activities. Minimum quarterly registration is six (6) or more credit hours.

Office Information Systems Program Scholarship - \$500

Awarded to entering, returning, current or transfer students who are pursuing an associate degree in the Office Information Systems (OIS) program. Recipients selected based upon their academic records, situational needs, work or volunteer experience, school or community activities. Minimum quarterly registration is six (6) or more credit hours.

High School Counselor Appreciation Scholarship - \$300

Awarded by the high school counselor who attends the WSU-LC “High School Counselor Appreciation Luncheon” and wins the scholarship drawing. The winning counselor will choose a recipient from among their 2010 top graduates who plan to attend the Lake Campus.

Merritt Wood Memorial Scholarship – \$100

Awarded to an entering, current, returning, or transfer student. Recipient selected according to his/her situational needs and academic records.

Loan Opportunities

Borrowers must register for at least six (6) credit hours each quarter. Preference is given to students who are pursuing a two-year technical program. Technical programs include: Office Information Systems, Technical Studies, Management Information Systems, and Financial Management Technology. Repayment begins nine (9) months after graduation, or after the recipient no longer attends the Lake Campus. Recipients are allowed up to three (3) years to repay.

Roland & Agnes Clausing Loan Funds are available to entering, current, returning, or transfer students who are graduates of St. Marys Memorial High School with cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 or higher. Loans made up to \$2,000. The loan application form is available at the WOEF-LC Scholarship Office, 104 Dwyer Hall, Lake Campus.

Shelby County Loan Funds are available to Shelby County entering, current, returning, or transfer students who have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 or higher. Loans made up to \$500. The loan application form is available at the WOEF-LC Scholarship Office, 104 Dwyer Hall, Lake Campus.

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How to Complete the Scholarship Application

The Application Form

1. Read and follow instructions to the letter. Do not leave any item blank. If it does not apply, write "NA". Type or print clearly using black ink.
2. Make several copies of the application form before you begin writing in case you make a mistake and wish to start over.
3. Because an award's criteria can include the applicant's major as a requirement, make sure that the Lake Campus's records accurately reflect your chosen major.
4. You may attach additional sheets if you run out of space when listing your community service and your involvement in extracurricular activities. Resist the temptation to send supporting materials that are not requested in the application.
5. Each part of the application packet can be submitted separately, but make sure all parts are received or postmarked no later than **5 p.m., March 1, 2010**. Make copies of everything you send. Don't forget to sign and date your application.

The Essay

1. Answer all parts of the essay question(s) completely.
2. Proofread your application carefully. Use your computer's spelling and grammar check features. Have a parent, teacher, or friend read your essay.

Confidential References

1. Request two (2) confidential references from people who know you well. Your references may be either an academic instructor or an employer who can comment on your academic potential and performance or your work habits.
2. It is polite to give your recommenders at least a one-month advance notice.
3. Give your references instructions by providing one of the attached "Confidential Scholarship Reference" forms. Be sure to add your name and signature to the form giving your reference permission to respond. Remember, they have busy lives and may have other deadlines.
4. "Confidential" means that you cannot view what is written by your recommender. The person providing your reference will need to mail his/her completed reference or return it to you in a sealed envelope for you to submit. Provide your recommender with a pre-addressed return envelope with affixed postage and remind him/her of the March 1st deadline.

Transcripts

1. Request a transcript from the school that you most recently attended. Allow plenty of time for this to be mailed and received if you are unable to go to the school in person.

Selection Process and Timeline

November 19, 2009 – March 1, 2010: Application packets are available for pick-up at the Lake Campus and your local high school counselor offices or can be accessed and printed online at <http://www.wright.edu/lake/prospective/scholarships.html>

March 1, 2010 at 5 p.m is the deadline to apply. All application parts must be received at this date & time to be considered.

Mid- March: Committee members meet to complete the award process. Award notices are sent to those applicants chosen to receive an award. Recipients are reminded to send their scholarship sponsor a thank you note.

End of March: Any award that is declined in the first round of the notification process may be re-awarded to the next eligible applicant with the next highest rating. Letters are sent to those applicants who did not receive an award.

May 1st: Accepted scholarship awards are posted to the recipients' financial aid and bursar accounts for the academic year.

August 15th: Last day to submit a scholarship disbursement petition.

1st Sunday of Fall Quarter: The Scholarship Committee hosts an award ceremony at the Lake Campus for recipients and their families followed by a reception. Certificates of award are given to the scholarship recipients. Photographs of committee members, university administration and recipients are taken for news releases to local newspapers.

June, 2011: An *Annual Report to the Community* is given by the President of Wright State University and the Dean of the Lake Campus in late spring each year. Scholarship recipients are invited to attend and are recognized for their accomplishment. Scholarship sponsors, WSU-LC faculty and staff, donors and the Western Ohio Educational Foundation (WOEF) Board of Trustees are also invited to attend and meet the recipients.

2. What do you consider to be the single most important societal problem? Why?

If you are eligible to apply for the **Lake Improvement Association (LIA) Scholarship & WOEf matching award (page 5)**, write an additional paragraph outlining your thoughts on environmental issues in our region/watershed.

☉ Need-based Scholarship Essay (Optional)

Please use a separate sheet of paper to answer the following questions in essay form **if you would like to be considered for a need-based grant or scholarship**. Essays should be typed, double spaced, and printed on one side. Each answer should be approximately one-half page in length:

From a financial standpoint, what impact would a WOEf scholarship have on your situation? State any special personal or family circumstances affecting your need for financial assistance. How do you plan to finance your college education?

☉ Confidential References

Submit two (2) confidential references from an academic instructor or employer who can comment on your academic potential or work aptitude and performance, citing specific examples where possible and any personal qualities that he/she feels are pertinent. All information will be used in confidence. Supply each reference with a signed reference form. (Pages 11-12)

☉ Transcript(s)

Submit a copy of your current high school transcript(s) and your college test scores (ACT or SAT). If you have already submitted your high school transcript with your University admission application, you do not need to submit an additional transcript with this application.

☉ Supporting Documentation (Optional)

Submit a completed *Veteran Status Documentation* form (page 14) if eligible for the Celina VFW Scholarship (page 2).
