2012 - 2013 WOEf Undergraduate Scholarship Application
For Students Direct-From-High-School
Intended for 2012 High School Graduates Who Will Attend the Lake Campus of Wright State University

Application Deadline: February 15, 2012

Scholarship recipients must register for the required minimum credit hours in classes offered at the Lake Campus. Funds will not be disbursed unless the recipient registers at least twelve (12) or more credit hours per semester unless otherwise noted. Registration must be completed by the first day of the semester.

The award amount will be divided equally and applied toward the recipient's fall and spring semester fees. Should a recipient be unable to attend either of these semesters, he/she may petition in writing to request to use a one-semester disbursement during the summer semester of the award year. If a recipient is graduating mid-year of the academic year, he/she may petition in writing to request that the total award be applied to his/her fall semester. All letters of petition should be sent to the Scholarship Coordinator, WOEf-LC Scholarships, 104 Dwyer Hall, 7600 Lake Campus Drive, Celina, Ohio 45822 and received prior to the 15th day of August of the award year.

Recipients must maintain the academic standards of their intended major and/or scholarship sponsor. If a recipient does not maintain the required academic standards, he/she can be placed on scholastic probation and future scholarship disbursements withheld.

A recipient placed on probation must show continuous academic improvement to receive future distributions. To be removed from scholastic probation, the recipient must attain the required grade point average (GPA). Recipients placed on probation will be ineligible to receive any other Lake Campus scholarship for one (1) year after the scholastic probation period ends.

- The combined totals of Western Ohio Educational Foundation (WOEF) scholarship assistance may not exceed the total cost of tuition.
- All Wright State University grade point averages (GPA) are based on a 4.0 grading system.
- Scholarships are awarded on an "as funds are available" basis.
- Application materials sent by mail must be postmarked by the Application Deadline to be considered.
- Applicants must apply for admission to Wright State University as a degree-seeking student and submit all transcripts and test scores prior to the Application Deadline.
- The University and the Foundation reserve the right to cancel a scholarship award if a recipient is found guilty of academic dishonesty.

Awarded to an entering, current, returning, or transfer student who resides in Allen, Auglaize, Darke, Mercer, Shelby or Van Wert County and has a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher. Recipient must major in Music or demonstrate an interest in Music.
