## ***AUDITION INFORMATION***

### **Who may audition for Collegiate Chorale?**

- Auditions are open to **all members of the Wright State community**, including students, staff, and faculty, regardless of major.
- All **voice majors** who are **sophomores, juniors, or seniors** *must* audition for Collegiate Chorale.
- **Freshman voice majors** are automatically assigned to the University Chorus, conducted by Dr. Collins. Freshman voice majors who wish to audition for Collegiate Chorale should discuss this with Dr. Dahlman.
- **Existing members of Collegiate Chorale** who received no grade lower than B in Collegiate Chorale, and who finished the Spring quarter in good standing, do not need to re-audition. Those who make a Collegiate Chorale grade lower than B or did not finish the year in the group need to re-audition.

### **What do the auditions consist of?**

There are three rounds: Round One, Callback Round, and Final Round:

#### ROUND ONE:

- Monday, August 29 or Tuesday, September 6 in Dr. Dahlman's office
- Sign up for a time on Dr. Dahlman's door.
- Fill out a Collegiate Chorale Audition Form and bring it with you to your Round One audition.
- Your audition will consist of vocalization, pitch memory, and sight-singing.
- You do not need to bring anything with you, other than the audition form.

#### CALLBACK ROUND:

- Wednesday, September 7, 2-2:50 PM, CAC M152
- 50-minute rehearsal with existing members of Collegiate Chorale.

#### FINAL ROUND:

- Wednesday, September 7, 6-9 PM, CAC M152
- Group audition with Collegiate Chorale.
- Open to the public.

### **When will I find out if I made it into Collegiate Chorale?**

A list of all members (new and returning) will be posted on Dr. Dahlman's door on Thursday, September 8.
