If a person has been convicted of or pleaded guilty to the commission of two theft-related offenses or a combination of any two of the following theft-related offenses, in two or more criminal actions, the applicant is barred from providing direct care to older adults:

- Theft
- Identity fraud
- Passing bad checks
- Misuse of credit cards
- Forgery; identification care offenses
- Medicaid fraud
- Insurance fraud
- Receiving stolen property
