Requirements for Clinical Practice Hours

- The clinical practice must have occurred within the past two (2) years (24 months). A minimum of 1000 hours of direct clinical practice is required.
- All clinical practice requirements must have been met while the individual held a PNP licensure to practice in the state or territory in which the clinical practice occurred.
- Clinical practice hours should reflect direct “hands-on” assessment and clinical management of children. Practice time does not include the management, supervision or education of other personnel or students to help achieve patient care goals.
- Clinical practice hours may be volunteer time spent providing direct pediatric nursing care.
