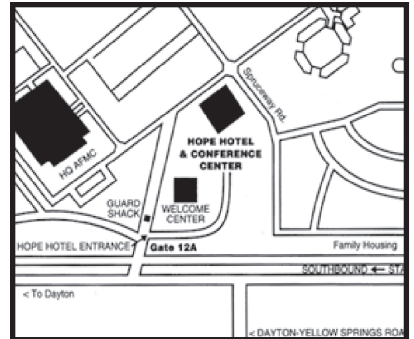
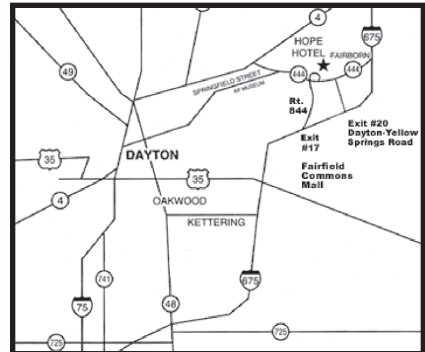

PLENARY SPEAKERS

CLAIRE BURKE DRAUCKER, PHD, RN, CS

Dr. Draucker is a distinguished university professor at Kent State University's College of Nursing. She also serves as the Angela Barron McBride Distinguished Visiting Professor at Indiana University School of Nursing and an adjunct professor for the University Of Pennsylvania School Of Nursing. She is widely published and has received extensive funding for her research in the areas of Adolescent Dating Violence, Sexual Violence, and Healing from Interpersonal Violence.

DIANNE DITMER, PHD, RN, CFN, CRM, CMI-III, CHS-III, DABFN, SANE, FACFE

Dr. Ditmer is a certified forensic nurse and clinical educator at Kettering Medical Center in Dayton, Ohio. She also serves as adjunct faculty at Kettering College of Medical Arts. Dr. Ditmer is a credentialed Fellow of the American College of Forensic Examiners International (ACFEI) and Diplomate of the American Board of Forensic Nursing (DABFN). She is widely published and speaks internationally on topics including forensic nursing, workplace violence, caring for vulnerable populations, and the impact of violence on multi-cultural, multi-generational patients.
