Why should you apply?

Accounting/finance students should submit resumes because there is a demand for student workers who will, hopefully, transition to permanent employment.

What should you expect?

Students should include references that will allow the base employers to reach out to faculty to get recommendations. Once they receive a resume, students should expect a phone interview asking about goals, strengths/weaknesses, ability to be a self-starter, etc. Then the process continues if the phone interview goes well.
