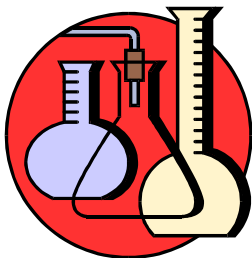
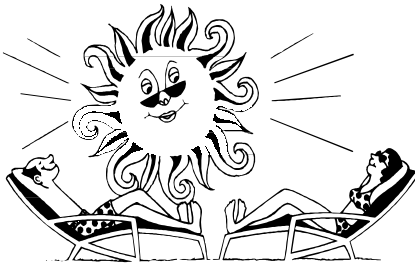


A True Technology Transfer Success Story...

A recent Community of Science (COS) newsletter included an article about a University that has teamed up with a manufacturer to advance the development of a product that may prevent or reduce the harmful effects of the sun, particularly skin cancer.

The industry/university partnership has resulted in the formation of a company that will continue the development of the product and seek approval from the Food and Drug Administration. The manufacturer will contribute a royalty-free, exclusive license of the patents to the new company, while the University will underwrite independent clinical trials.

COS points out that an increasing number of research sponsors, including the National Science Foundation and the National Institutes of Health, are turning to the COS expertise database to locate potential applicants and assessors.
