This form may not be used to petition to withdraw from a class or for removal of hours and points. - 1. The student completes and submits form providing all relevant supporting documentation.
- 2. The instructor reviews the material and responds in writing to the petition. The instructor may recommend a change in the grade or evaluation, or that the grade or evaluation remains as assigned along with the rationale.
- 3. If the student does not agree with the instructor recommendation, the student may write a response and request a meeting with the supervisor and the instructor.
- 4. The supervisor makes a recommendation based on the results of the meeting. The recommendation is provided to the student.
- 5. If the student does not agree with the recommendation, the written documentation is forwarded to a UC petition committee consisting of three members of the University College staff or faculty who are not involved in the petition. The committee will review the documentation and written responses and make a recommendation.
- 6. If the student does not agree with petitions committee decision, he/she may meet with University College Dean. A final decision by the Dean will be transmitted to the student.
