- Women are in the majority, accounting for 70% of the enrollment, up 4% from 2001
- 14% are enrolled in associate degree programs
- 64% are enrolled in bachelor's degree programs
- 22% are non-degree students
- 27% of all students take 13-15 credit hours
- Average age of all students is 26 years
- Average age of full-time students is 23 years
- Average age of part-time students is 30 years
- Cumulative undergraduate grade point average is 3.028
- 29% of undergraduate students attend day classes only
- 20% of undergraduate students attend evening classes only
- 51% of undergraduate students attend both day and evening classes
- 71 associate's degrees were awarded during 2001-2002

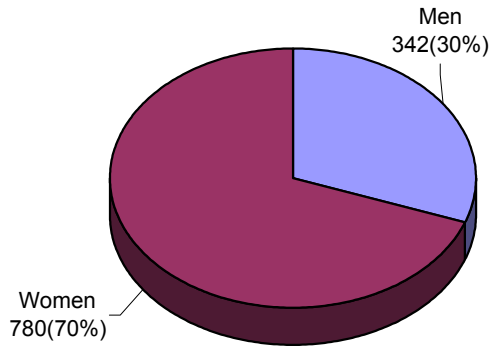

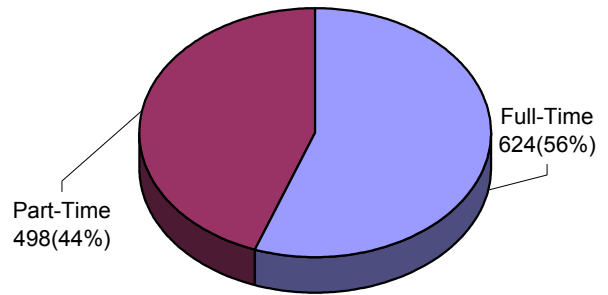

Student Headcount Enrollment

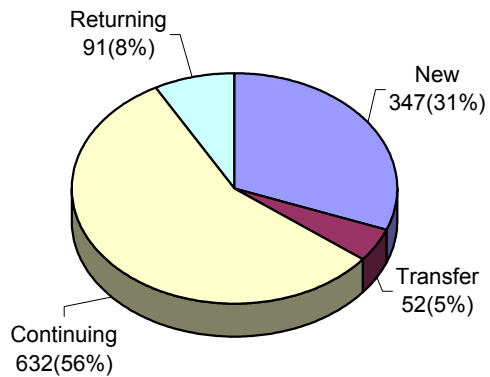

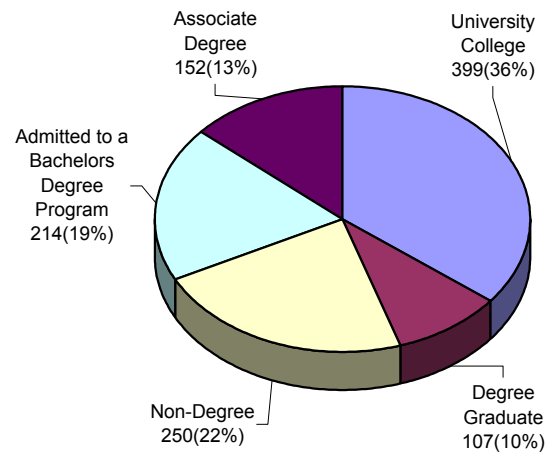

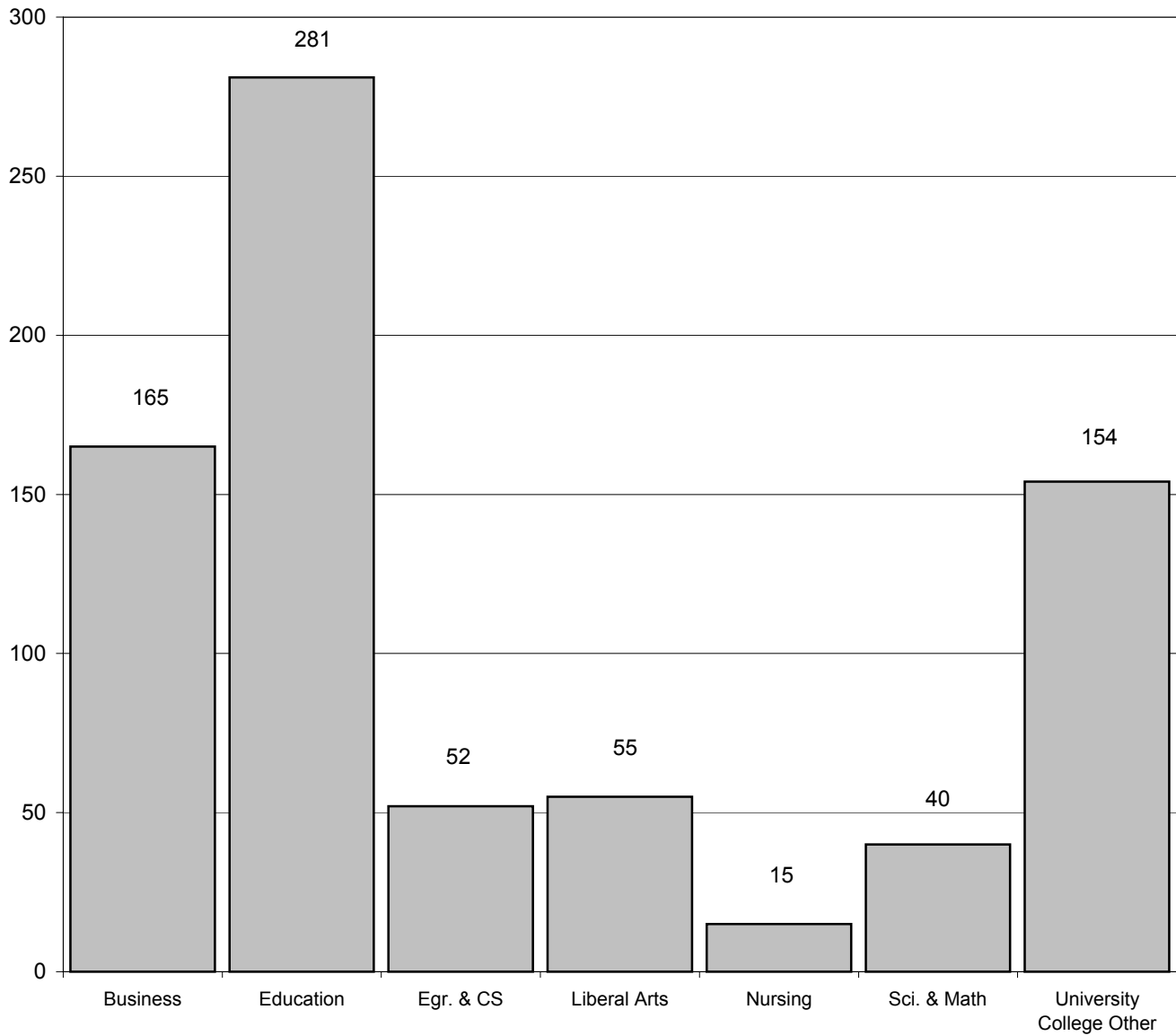

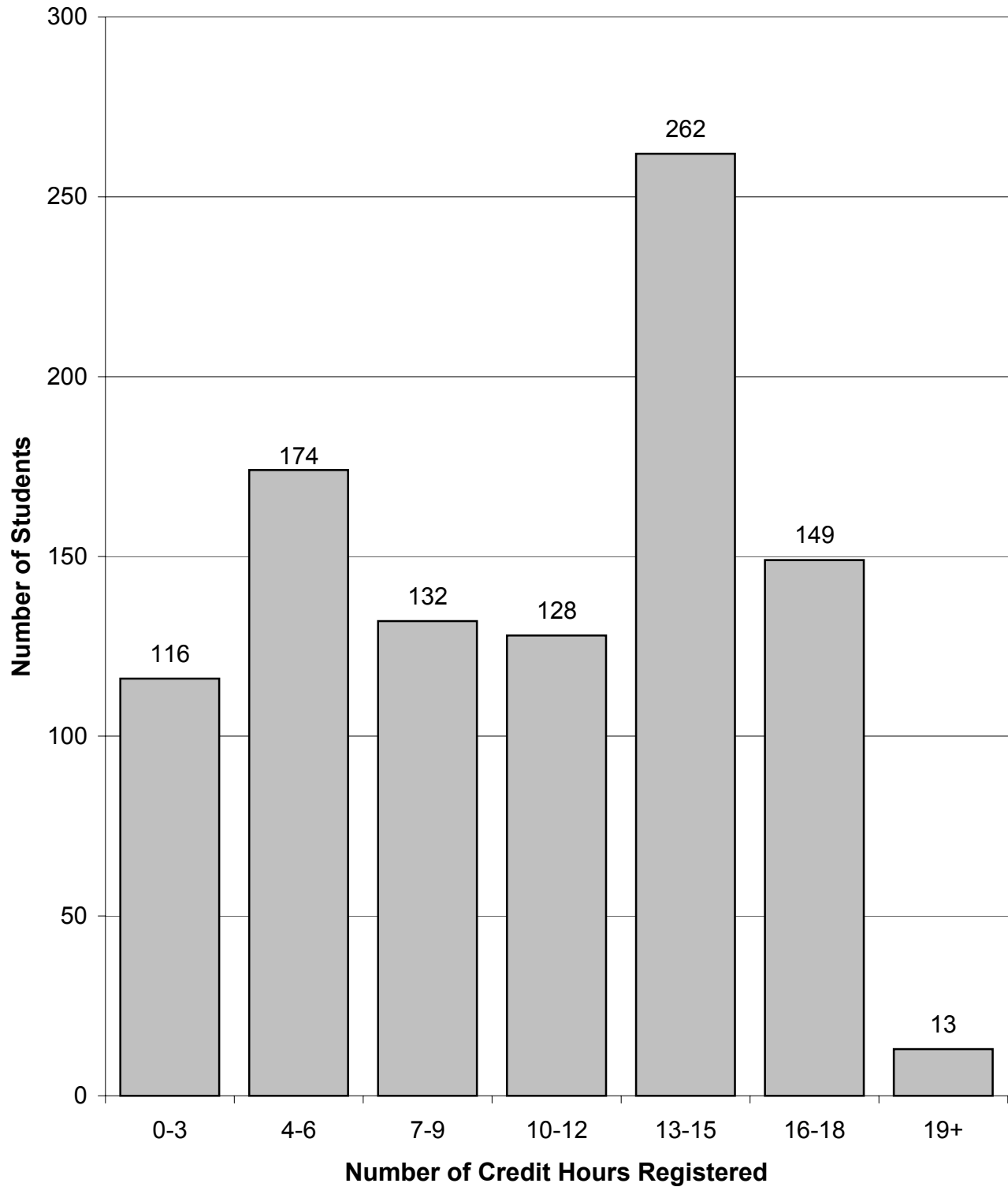

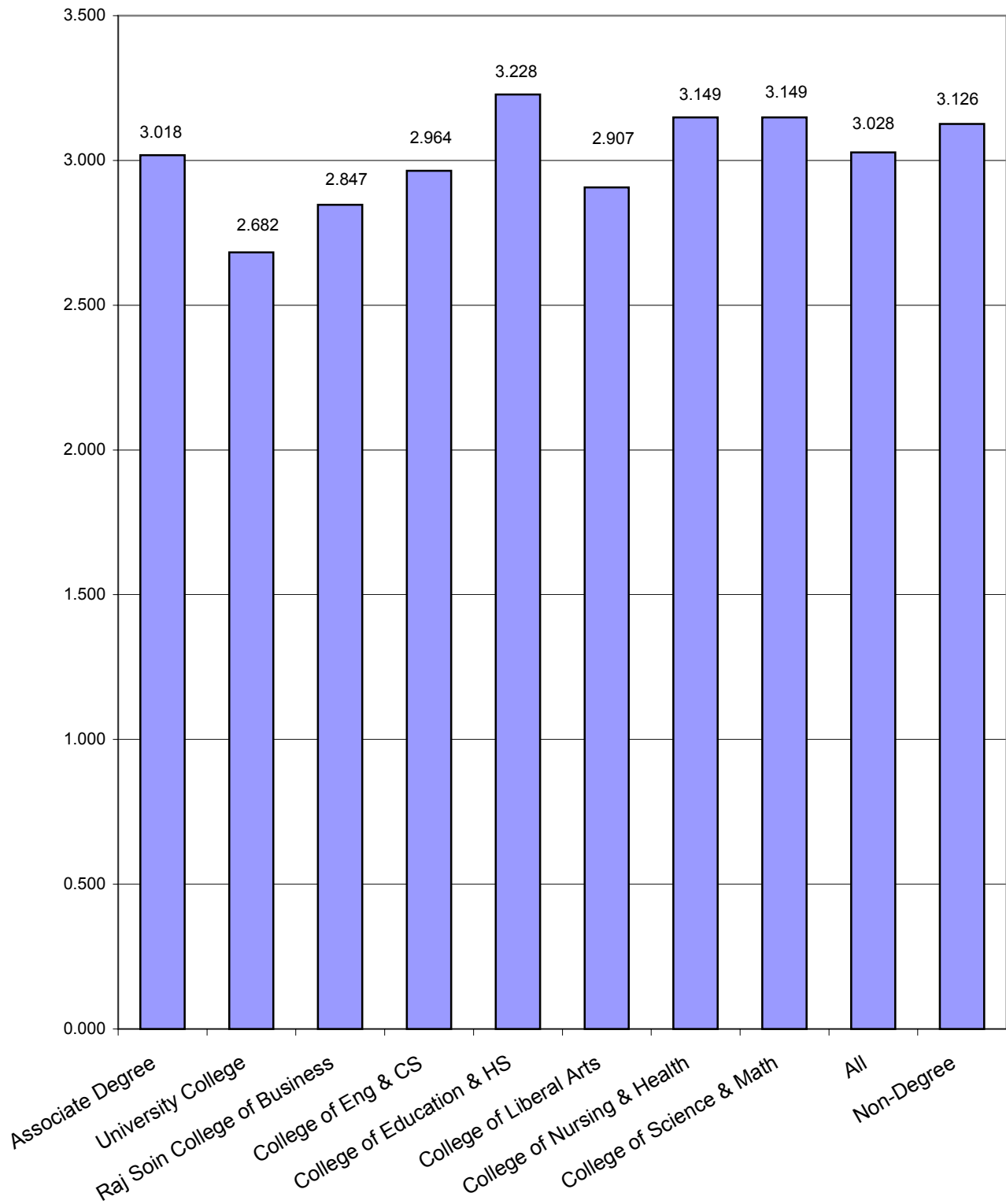
