For the past few years, Wright State University has provided free influenza immunizations for benefit eligible faculty and staff members. We are pleased to announce that we will continue to offer this benefit. For 2014, Human Resources, WSU College of Nursing and Health, and MedWork Occupational Health Care have teamed up to provide this service. As a benefit-eligible faculty or staff member, can receive an influenza immunization (Flu Shot) **at no cost to you.**

All faculty and staff are encouraged to receive flu shots. Individuals who are most at risk of contracting influenza are persons who are over age 65, persons who are under age 65 who have a chronic health condition such as heart, lung, or kidney disease or diabetes or are caregivers to people in these categories, all women who will be pregnant during the influenza season, health-care workers involved in direct patient care, out-of-home caregivers and people with children younger than 6 months in the household. If you are pregnant, please bring with you your physician's signed authorization to receive the vaccine.

Nurses with MedWork Occupational Health Care and WSU College of Nursing and Health will be providing the vaccinations. WSU has reserved ample supply of vaccinations to be available to benefit eligible employees. The first flu clinic will be held during and following the annual Health and Benefits Fair, **Wednesday, October 22nd from 10:00 AM through 4:00 PM.**

Please bring your Wright1 ID card or your Anthem medical insurance card and a signed authorization form which is available on the Human Resources website located at <http://www.wright.edu/sites/default/files/page/attachements/flushotform.pdf>. Please wear a loose-fitting shirt/top or a short-sleeved shirt/top to allow the nurse to administer the shot in the left or right deltoid on one of your arms.

Benefit eligible employees who carry WSU health benefits can seek immunizations from their personal physicians who are providing these shots. The amount of reimbursement for the cost of the flu shot provided by your personal physician depends on your health coverage. Contact your health insurance carrier at the telephone number listed on the reverse side of your identification card for confirmation of any benefit payable.
