Draft Resolution Concerning the creation of two new positions

Understanding,

The need to increase the efficiency of Student Government,

Realizing,

The need to represent the veteran, transfer, and continuing student population,

The Wright State University Student Government,

1. Supports the creation of the Graduate Student Assembly;
2. Authorizes the following senatorial positions expire at the end of Spring Quarter 2011:
 - i. School of Graduate Studies Senator
 - ii. School of Medicine Senator
 - iii. School of Professional Psychology Senator;
3. Authorizes the creation of the following senator position be created to be elected in Spring 2011 in preparation for Summer Quarter 2011:
 - i. Graduate Student Senate Liaison
 1. Will have the following duties and parameters
 - a. Will have voting rights
 - b. Must complete 9 in office hours in the Student Government Office per week
 - i. For the purpose of collaborating with other SG members on projects, meeting attendance and other required event attendance
 - c. Will receive a stipend of 1\3 tuition.
 - d. must agree to the Student Government Contract, and the Standard Operating procedure set out by each administration;
4. Authorizes the creation of the following cabinet position to be nominated in Spring Quarter 2011 in preparation for Summer Quarter 2011:
 - i. Director of Veteran-Transfer-Continuing Student (VTC) Affairs
 1. Will collect data, complete projects, and initiate programs to support the enrichment of students who are veterans of the armed forces, transfer students, or students continuing their education
 2. Must complete 13 office hours
 3. Will receive a stipend of ½ tuition
 4. Will have its inaugural nomination during the Spring Quarter 2011
 5. must agree to the Student Government Contract, and the Standard Operating procedure set out by each administration;
5. Calls for a committee be created, led by the Chief Justice to determine and execute the proper augmentations to both the Student Government bylaws and the Student Government Constitution in regards to the position changes as

prescribed in this document.

- i. The changes are to be prepared for senate confirmation before March 15, 2011;
