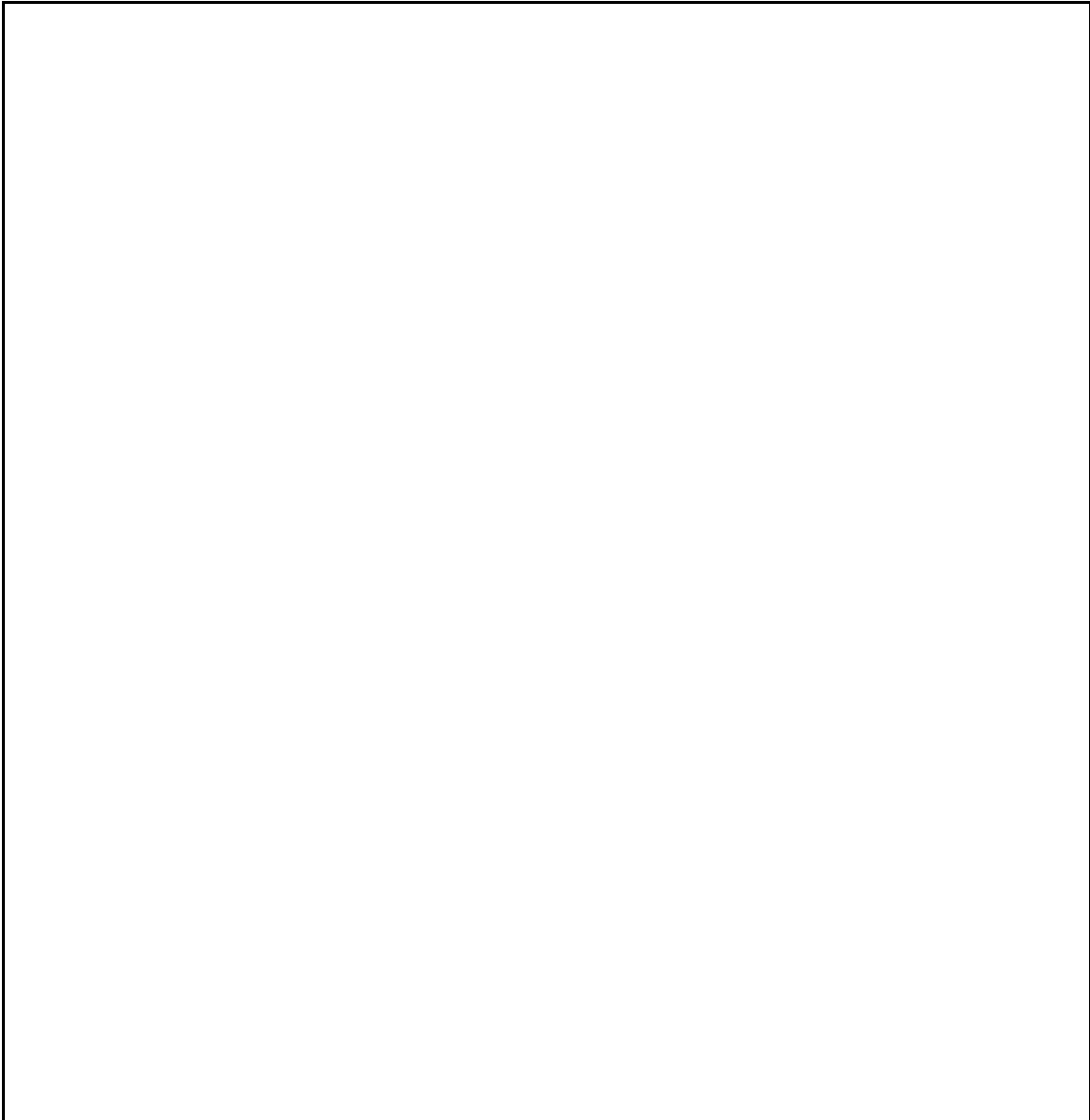

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Highlights

- Average age of full-time students is 23 years

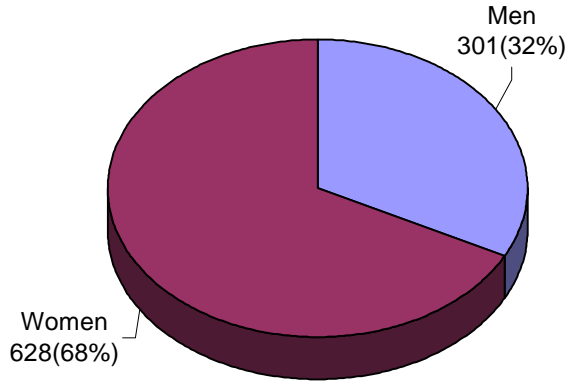

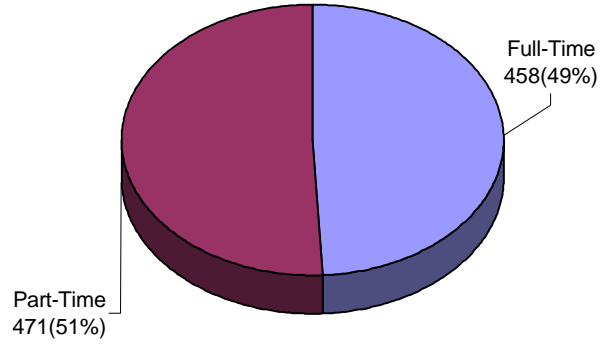

Student Headcount Enrollment

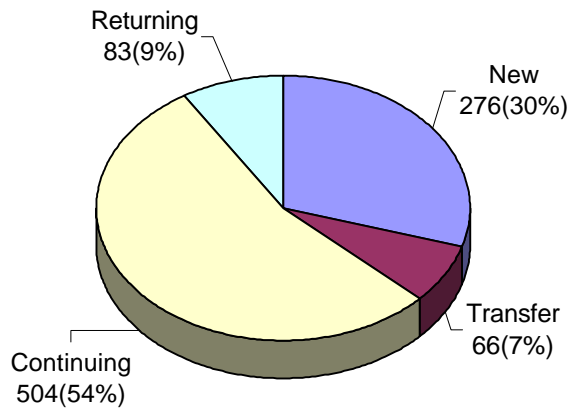

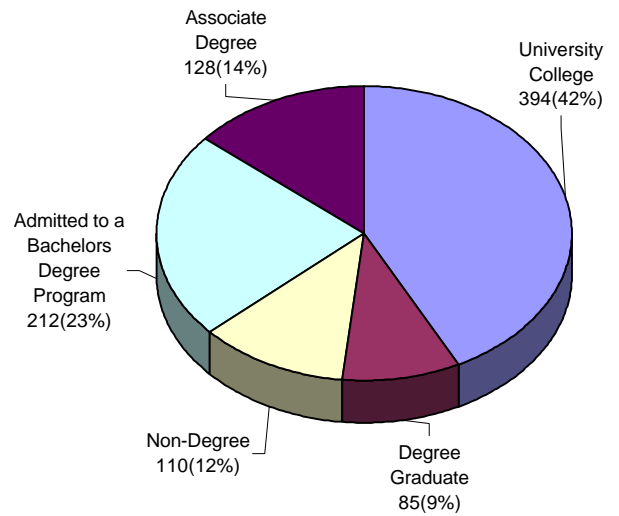

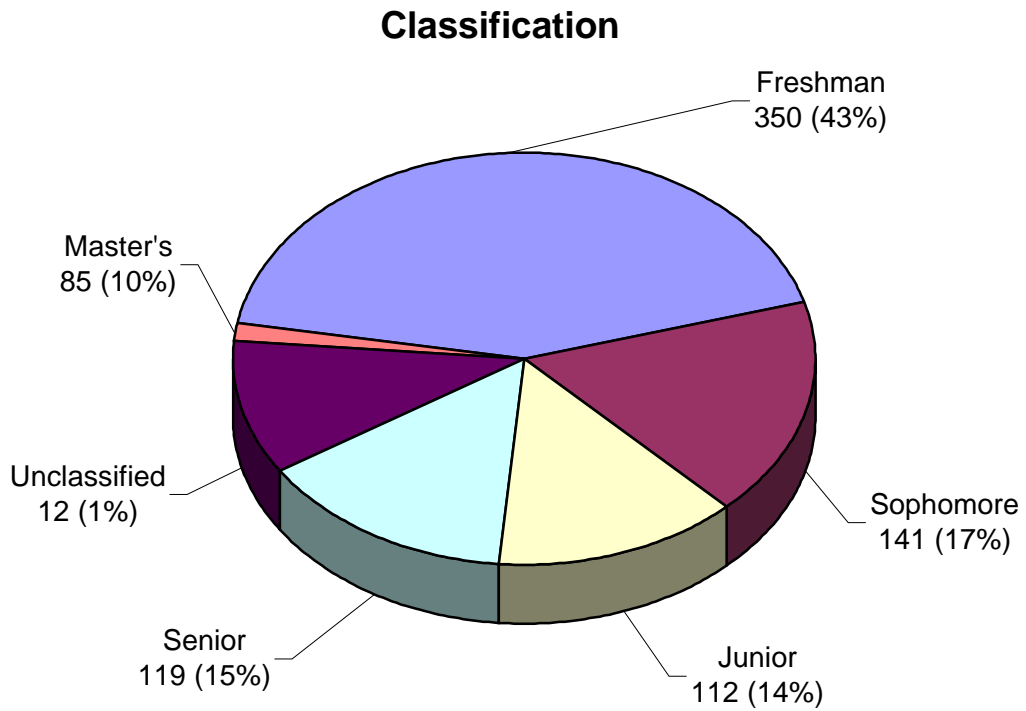

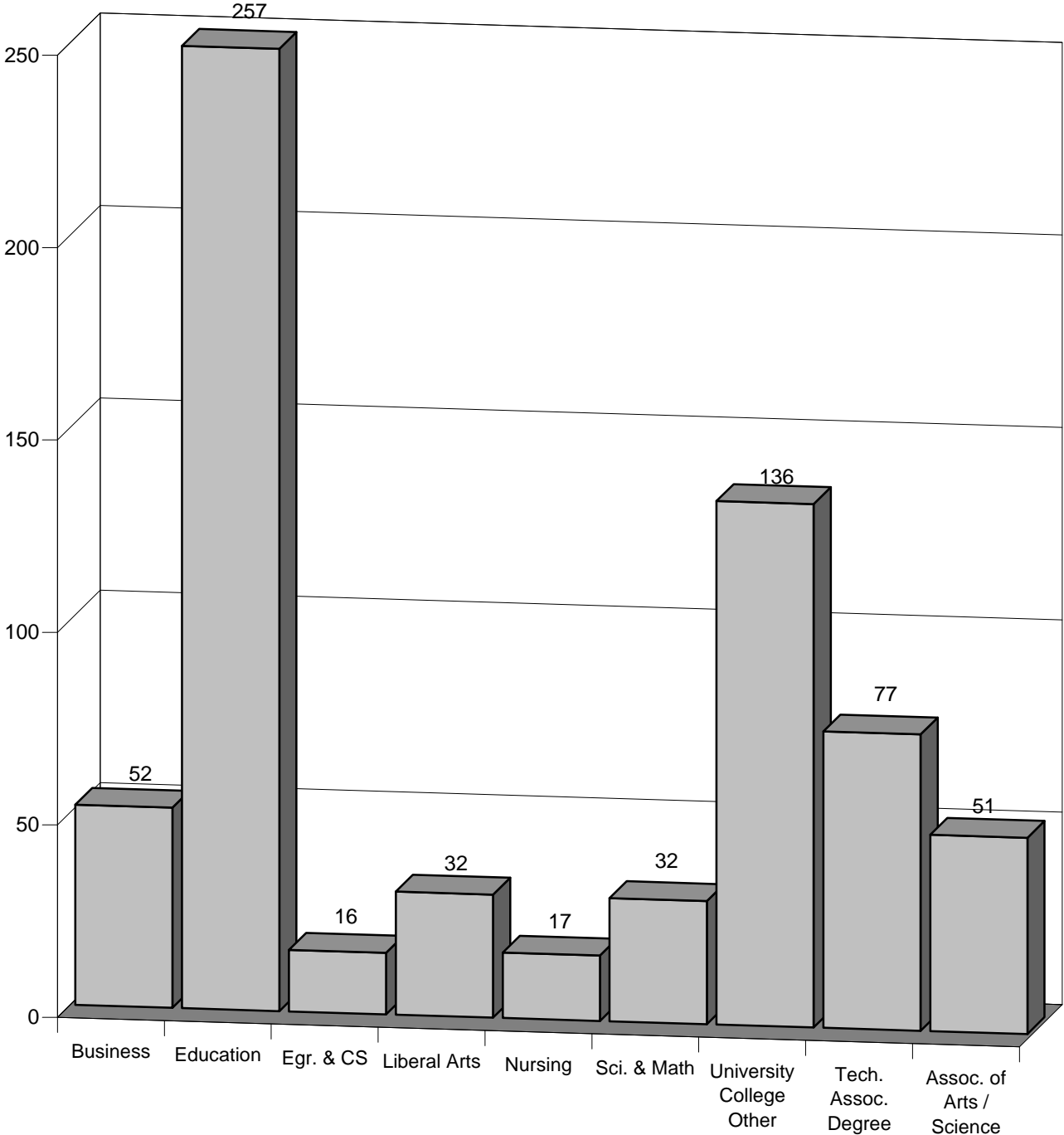

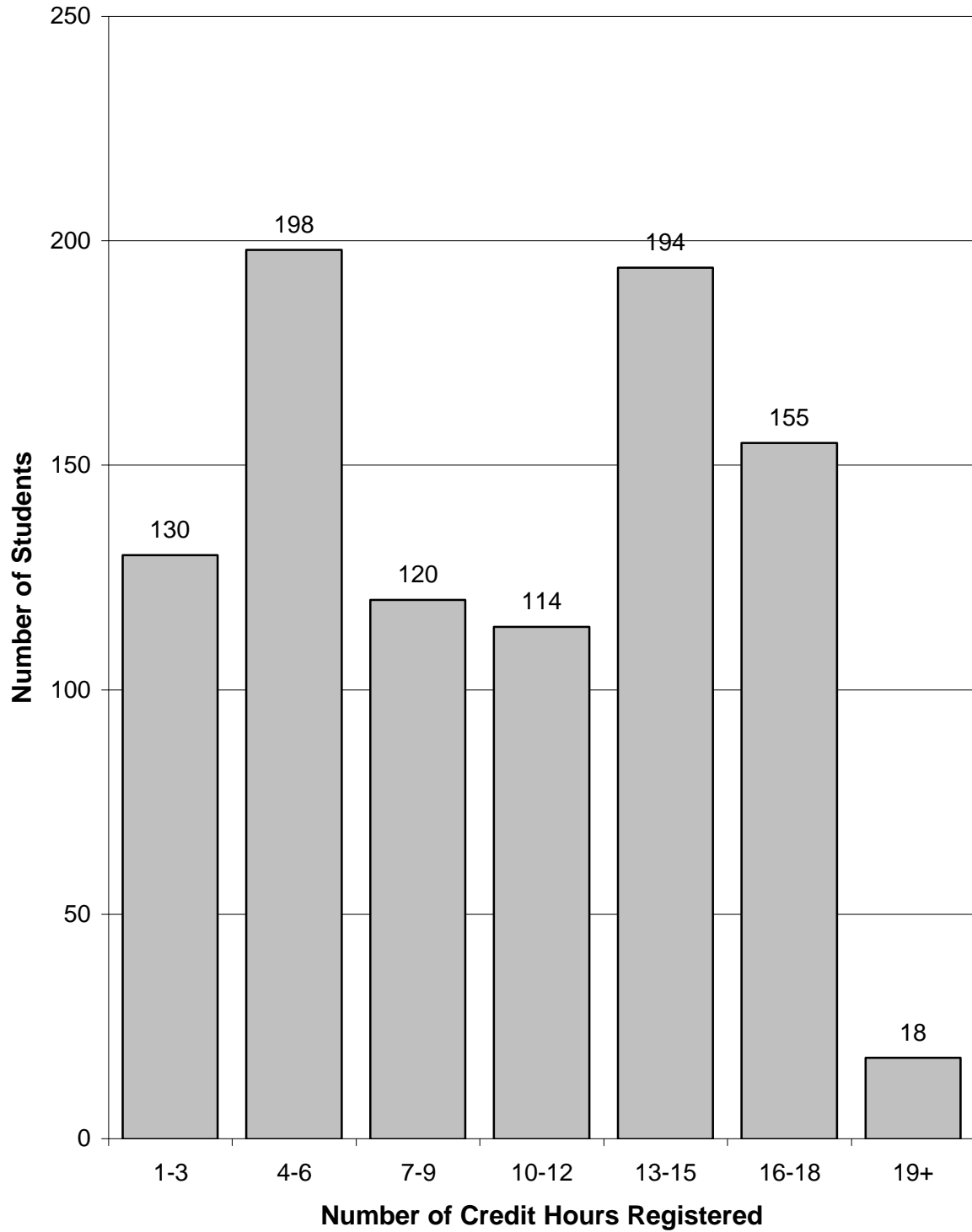

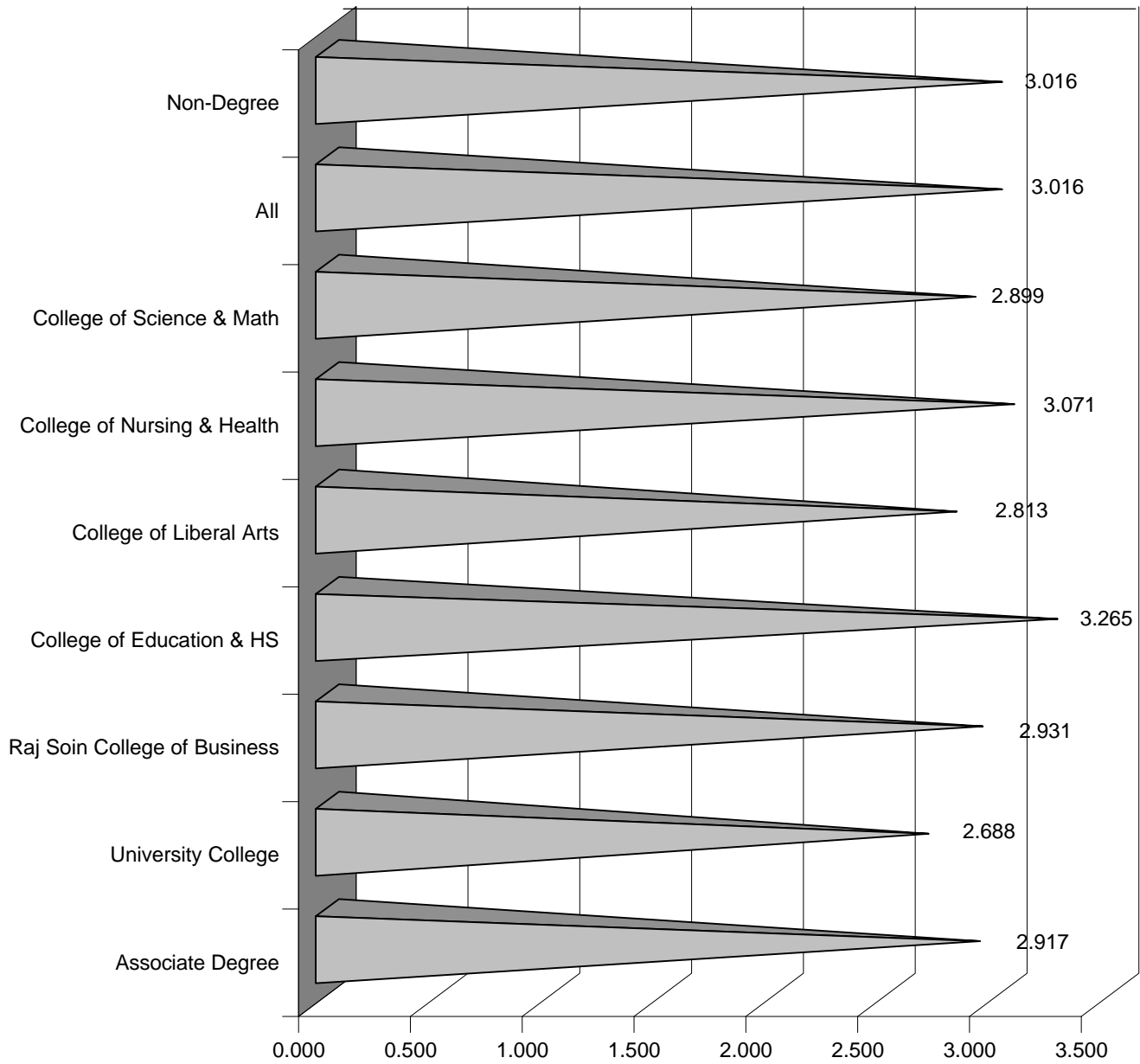
