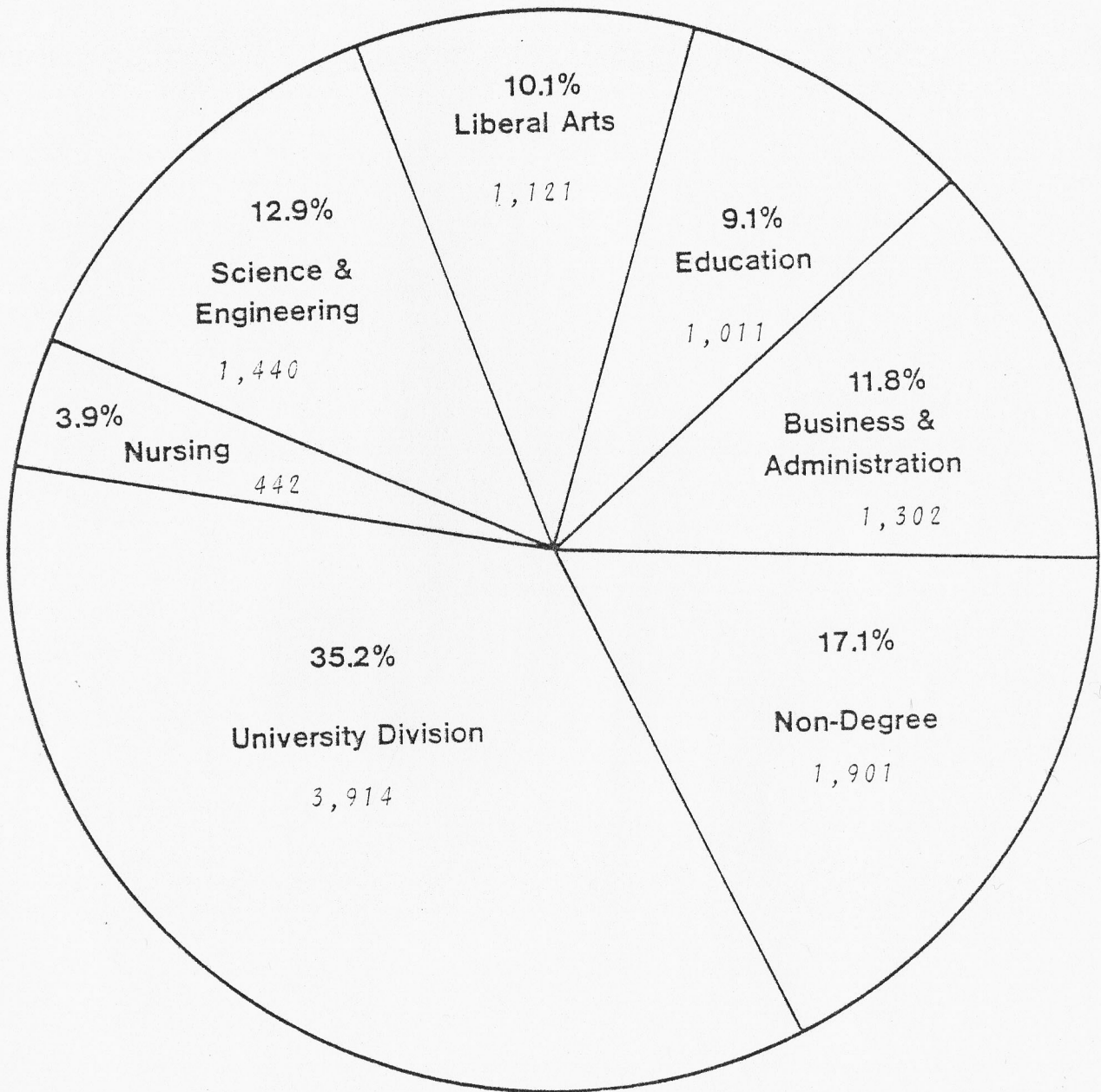

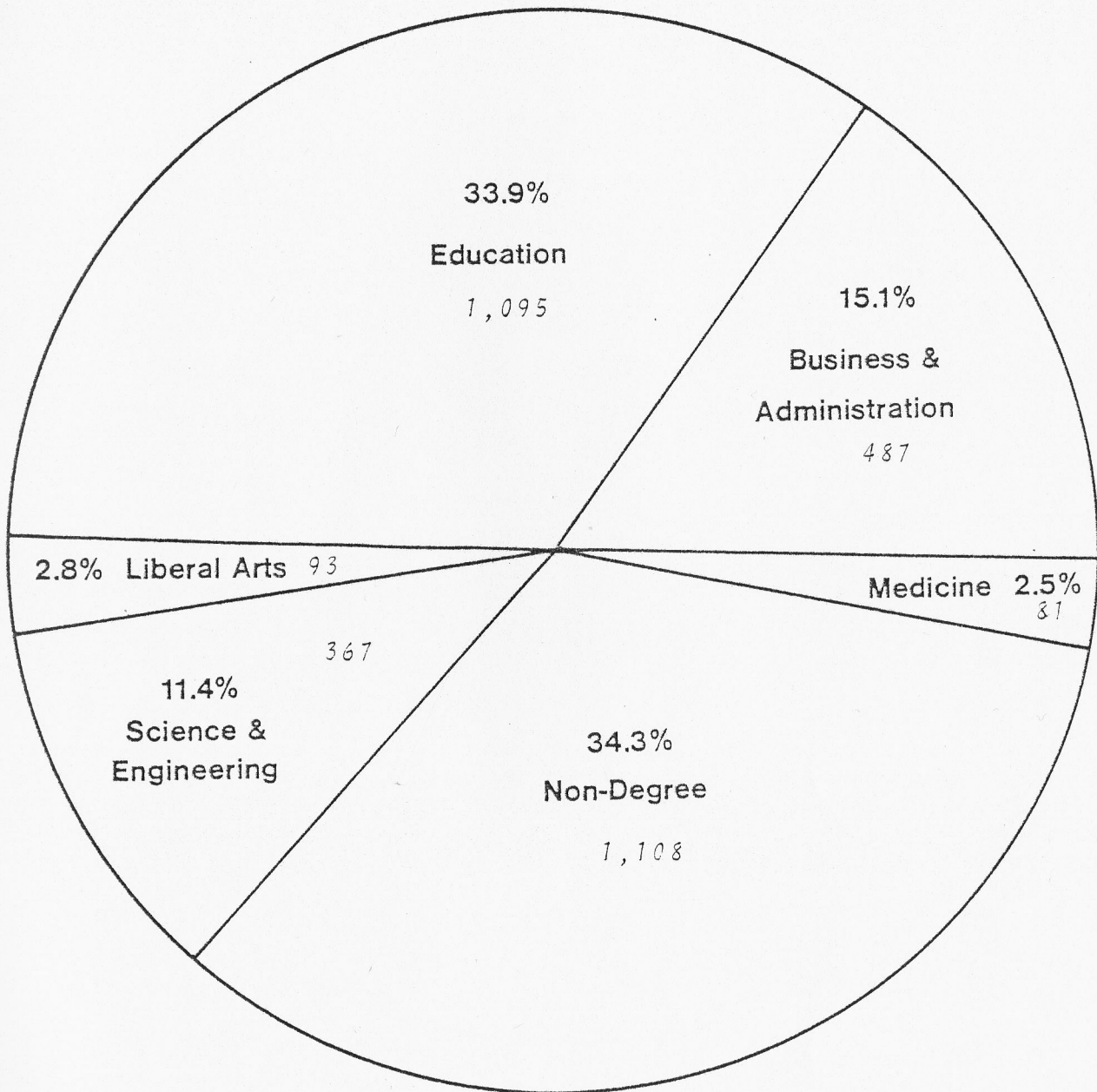

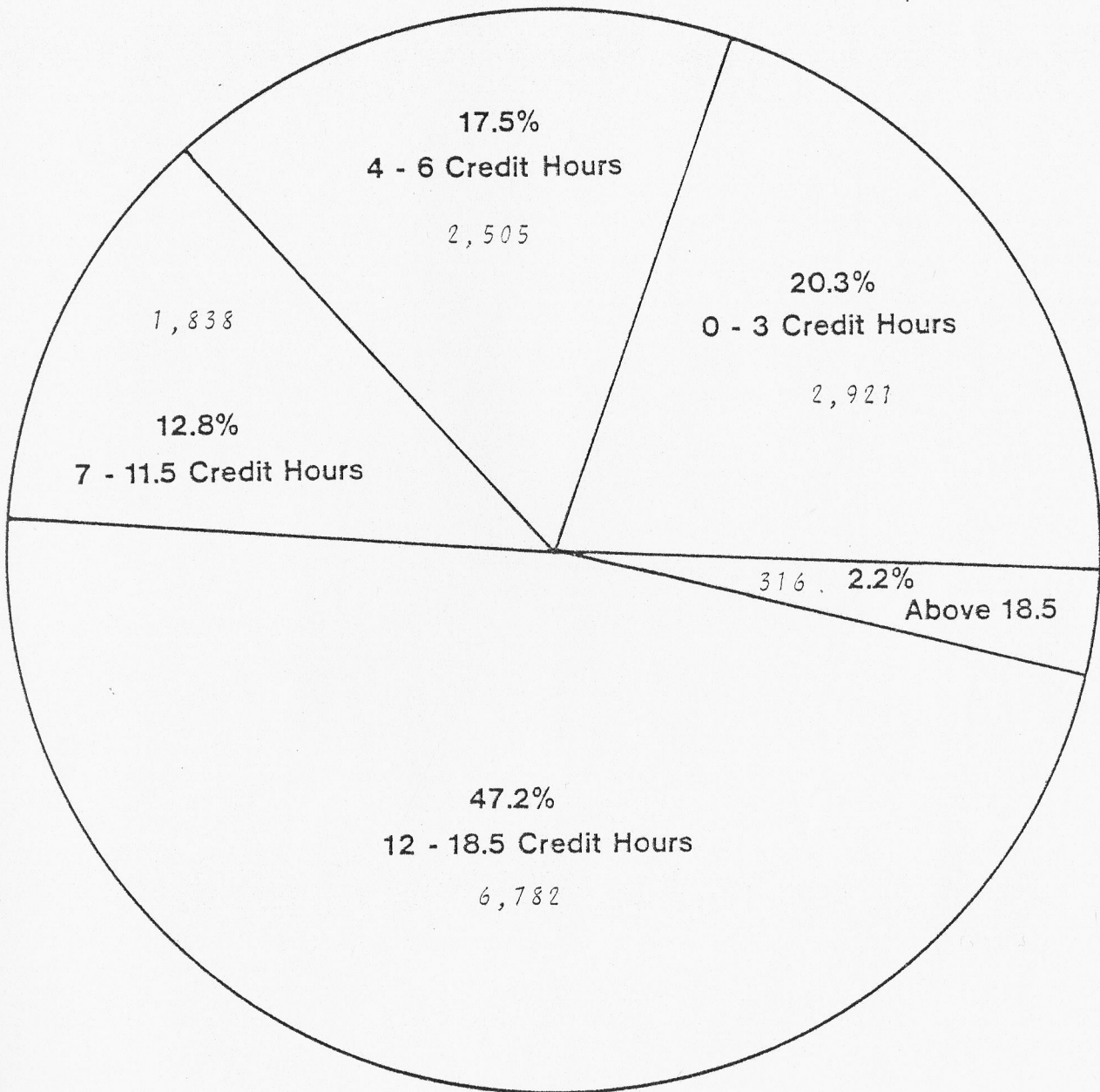

Undergraduate by College



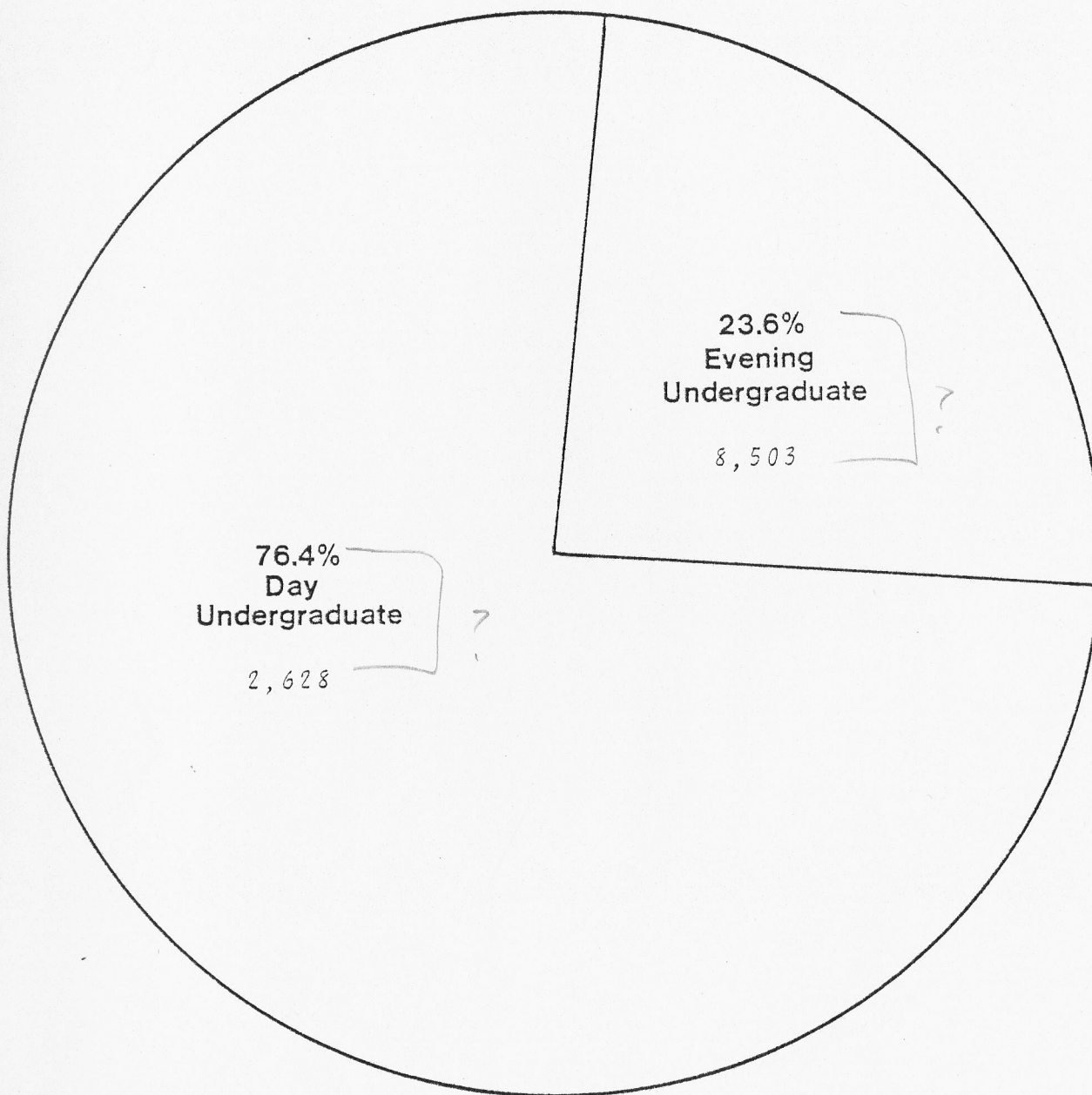
Wright State University

Fall 1977-1978



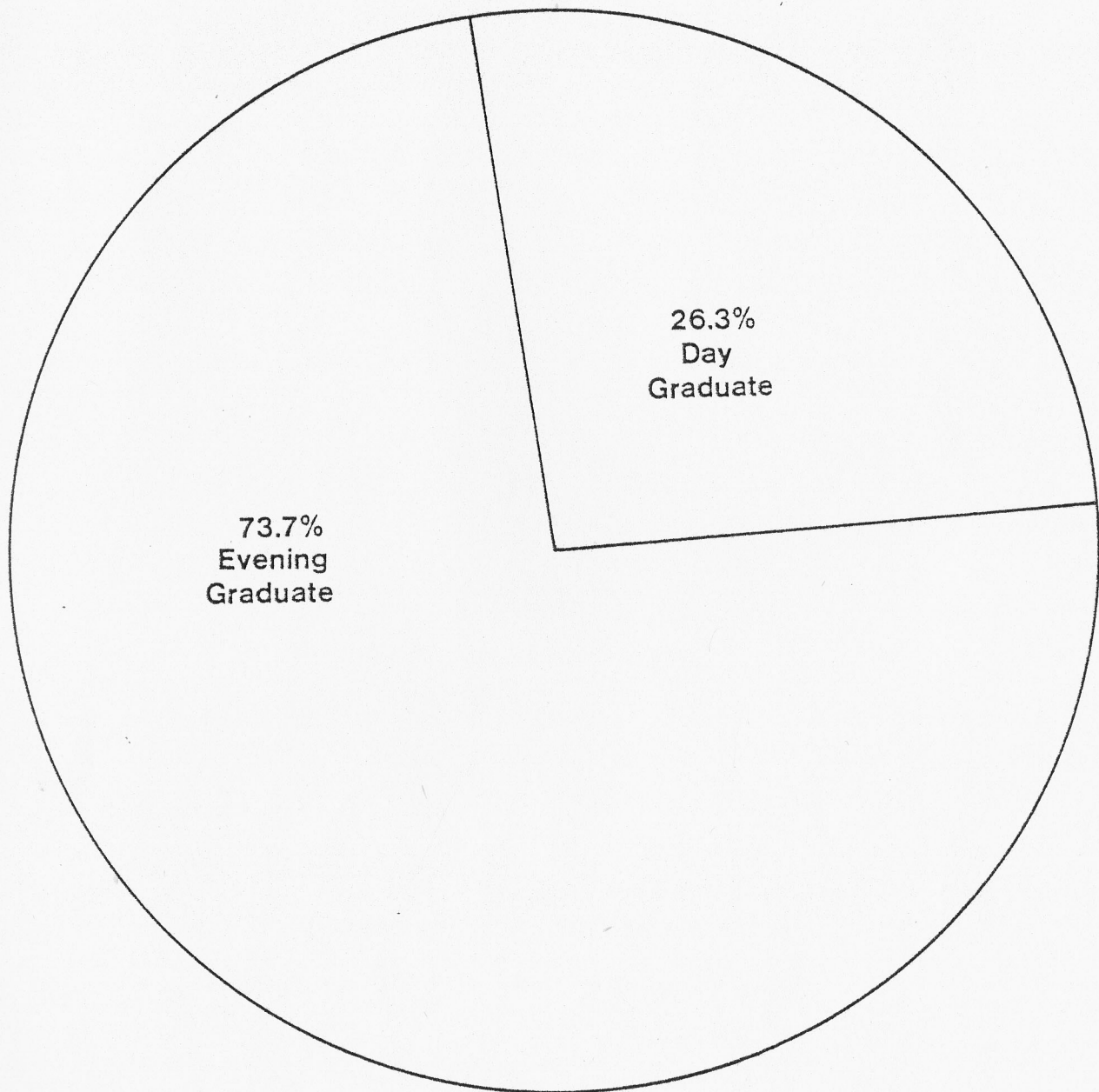
Wright State University

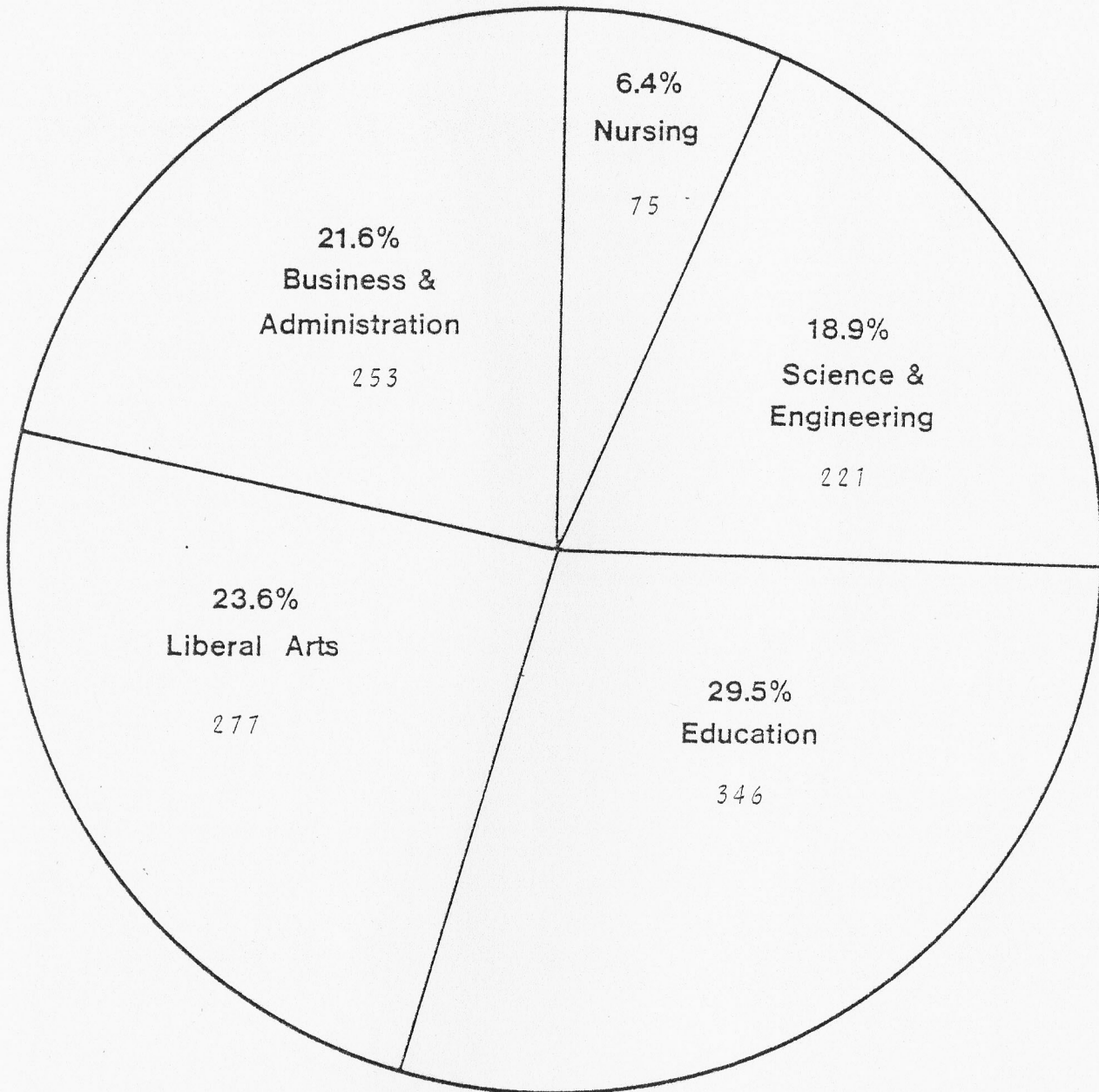

GRADES -- Fall Quarter, 1976

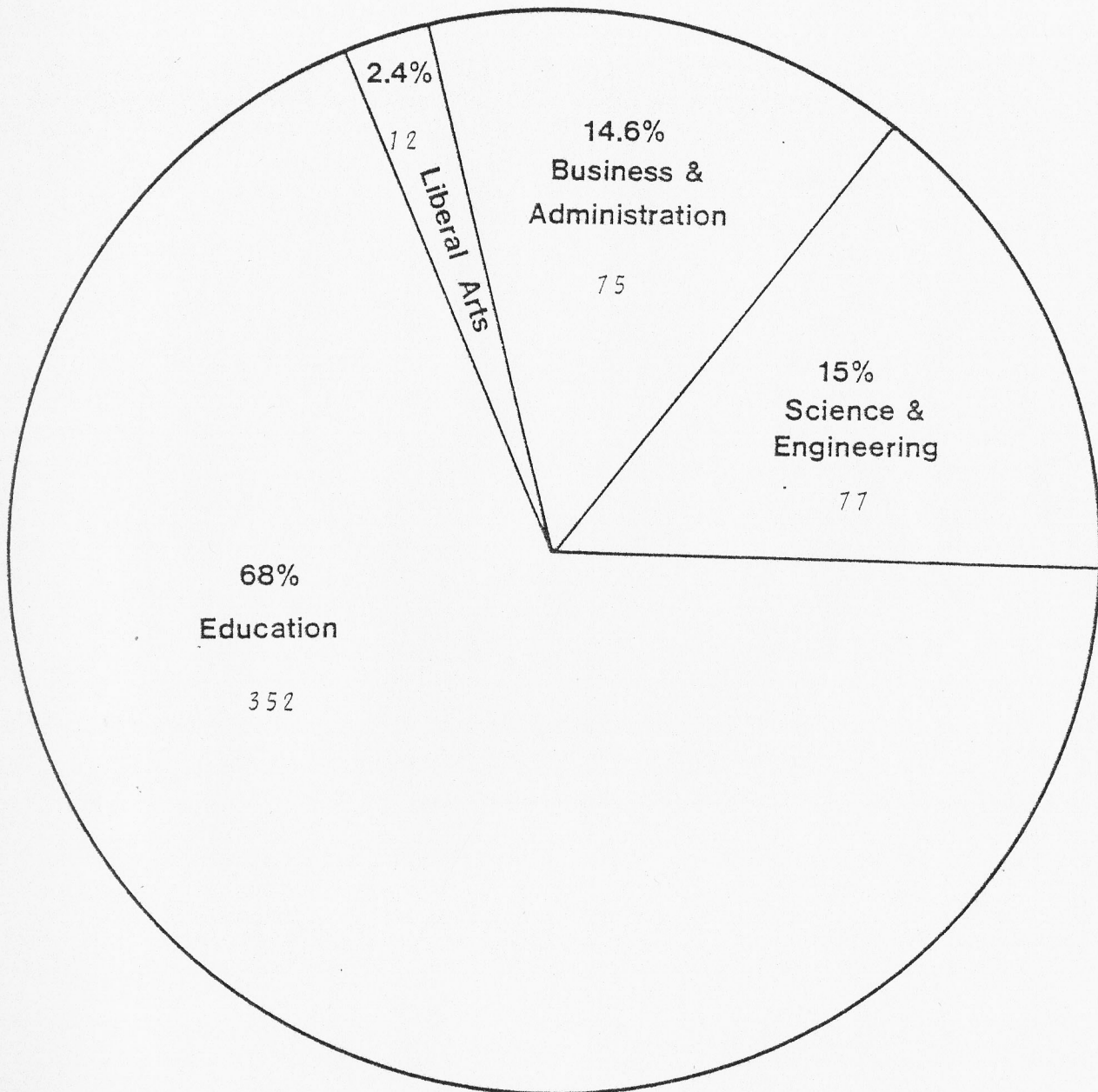
