10,841 (88%) of all undergraduate students have either indicated an interest or have been admitted to a program of study leading to a degree or certificate. New freshmen and transfer students (except music majors) with less than 24 hours of transferable credit from another institution are registered in the University Division. After earning 24 hours of credit and completing any required prerequisites a student may apply to one of the degree granting colleges or schools.




Ohio County of Residence
