

Using the Apple TV

An Apple TV allows you to show the screen from your device on the classroom projection screen using AirPlay. This allows you to move freely around the room while still being in control of what is shown to the class.

Connect to Apple TV

1. Connect to the 'WSU-Secure' wireless network using your campus username and password.

Note: Apple TV will not work unless you are connected to 'WSU-Secure' wireless

2. Select 'Apple TV' on the Extron touch panel.
3. Activate AirPlay in the Control Center of your device.
4. Tap the room that corresponds with your location.
5. Turn on 'Mirroring'.
6. Enter the code displayed on the Apple TV monitor.

Note: Your AirPlay connection might get interrupted when you lock your device, put it to sleep, or switch to a different app.

Disconnect from Apple TV

1. Turn off 'Mirroring' for the room in AirPlay.
2. Depending on your device, tap either 'iPhone' or 'iPad' from the list to disconnect from the Apple TV.

Important Notes

- Apple TV remotes can be used to regain control of the screen if someone has entered the code in a different device before you are able to connect. Press the 'Menu' button to manually disconnect any other users.
