Using NetSupport School Tutor

NetSupport School Tutor allows the instructor of a course to control all of the student computers within a computer lab or active learning space. Instructors can view the classroom as a whole, or an individual table of computers.

Launching NetSupport School Tutor

- 1. Launch 'NetSupport School Tutor' using the icon on the desktop.
- 2. All inactive stations will appear in gray by default.

To Power On Student Computers:

Do not click on an individual computer at this time. By default, all computers are selected.

- 1. Click on the 'Manage' icon in the toolbar.
- 2. Select 'Power On'.
- 3. Computers will turn from gray to green as they turn on.

To Power Off Student Computers:

- 1. Click on the 'Manage' icon in the toolbar.
- 2. Select 'Power Off'.
- 3. Computers will turn from green to gray as they shut down.
