- I. Printing Service
Steve Berberich's office will look into printing volume at nursing to look for solutions for slow printing.
Network printers were planned to be removed after 30 days after finishing the campus-wide transition. So far this was not enforced yet and existing printers that are still under warranty will still be supported until the end of that warranty.
Linux drivers provide only limit feature set. The managed printing service team is aware of the fact that we need to find a resolution to this issues in the future.
- II. Network/Firewall
Sometimes it takes multiple requests to take care of network/firewall changes. CaTS is in the process to change the ticketing system so that we can collect more data to find about where those issues exactly are at.
