Old Business -

<u>Bullying Policy</u> – A draft policy is currently being reviewed by Provost Sudkamp and Shari Mickey-Boggs.

<u>Survey Tools and Survey Protocols</u> – Action items will be shared at the June meeting. Council members suggested including definitions and instructions to clarify the uses of "confidential" and/or "anonymous" surveys.

<u>2017 Involuntary Separation Timetable – Communication will be sent to the university regarding the timeline.</u> Dr. Berberich is not aware of this date.

New Business -

Removal of civil service protections from classified employees – House Bill 187 allows the institutions to make changes to the Ohio Revised Code. Currently the administration is looking to remove "bumping" rights. Dr. Berberich began by stating that he respects the position that CSAC has taken by sharing this information with all staff and faculty. He included that he respects there may be differences of opinion. He stated that he and Shari Mickey-Boggs will be conducting small group meetings with classified staff to provide the opportunity for staff to ask questions. In order for this change to occur, the Board of Trustees must vote to approve the Resolution.

Revised hiring process for adjunct instructors (how does this impact staff who also adjunct)?

Dr. Berberich stated that the centralization of adjunct hiring will impact staff who adjunct. Staff who adjunct will be treated in the same manner as all adjuncts hired.
