

New ad hoc and special committee charges

April 16, 2018

CHARGE: ad hoc General Counsel Review committee

The Executive Committee of the Faculty Senate charges an ad hoc General Counsel Review committee to provide a report recommending actions that the University might make to better align the resources and mission of the Office of the General Counsel with the legal needs of the University. The ad hoc committee is charged to make progress in this effort during the summer 2018 term. The ad hoc committee shall make all reasonable effort to provide this report by August 31 so that it can be considered by the Executive Committee for discussion during the first Faculty Senate meeting of the 2018-19 academic year.

DRAFT CHARGE: UCC/GCC Joint Working Group for Curriculum Process Efficiency

The University Undergraduate and Graduate Curriculum Committees shall prepare a report regarding means by which Wright State's curriculum approval process might be improved or made more efficient. The Chairs of the UCC and GCC shall co-chair a working group, with membership as they determine appropriate, to make progress in this effort during the summer 2018 term. The working group shall make all reasonable effort to provide a report for the first Fall meetings of the UCC and GCC, so that the both bodies can forward a jointly approved final report to the Faculty Senate early in the Fall 2018 term.

CHARGE: USSC

The Undergraduate Student Success Committee shall prepare a report that summarizes progress in reducing the cost of textbooks for Wright State students and that proposes additional means whereby Wright State can be a leader in the area of textbook affordability. The USSC is encourage to empower a working group, as appropriate, to make progress in this effort during the summer 2018 term. The working group shall make all reasonable effort to provide a report for the first Fall meeting of the USSC, so that the USSC can forward a final report to the Faculty Senate early in the fall 2018 term.
