#### Activation



#### Student Government

 Executive Order 20Delays Student Government Elections until Fall 2020 begining on the first day of the semester

### University

- Extend withdraw deadline
- Pass/ Unsatisfactory option for students

Coronavirus Aid, Relief, Economic Security (CARES) Act



### COVID 19... CARES Act

### Issues with the CARES Act

- Many Students in the HE system fall into a unique category
  - To be eligible for the CARES Act stimulus you had to have filled your taxes as an independent
  - Students are often financially independent but may still be claimed by their parents for financial expediency. This is especially true at WSU
  - This has the effect of compounding the financial worries of students, which increases personal anxieties, which impacts academics.



## COVID 19... CARES Act Cont

- SGA has written a letter to Governor Mike DeWine
  - Describes this issue
  - Asks that he work with the Ohio Congressional Delegation on behalf of studer across the state
- Working with sister institutions through the Ohio Student Government Association to advocate for the same in a coordinated effort.
