Responsibilities of the Pledge

1. As a new member of the Delta Phi chapter you must act like a gentleman at all times. Once you are pledged in by the Delta Phi chapter you become a representative of not only this chapter but of the fraternity as a whole. Conduct unbecoming a gentleman or contrary to the maintenance of good order are grounds for immediate de-pledging. A Beta is to be “urbane in deportment and courteous in expression” at all times during your pledging
2. A new member of the Delta Phi chapter may at no time during his pledging use, harbor or sell illegal drugs. Anyone found in violation of this will be immediately dismissed. **NO QUESTIONS ASKED.** The active members of the Delta Phi chapter will have no part in any such activity
3. During your pledge period you are not consume any alcohol regardless of age. This is a period of acclimation to fraternity life. This is most easily accomplished through prevention of alcohol use and stressing what fraternity life is really about...**BROTHERHOOD.**
4. One of the most important responsibilities you now have is that you must help to carry the financial burden of this chapter. Insurance as well as materials for your pledge period will come out of this money. Payment plans are available. In order to continue with you pledge period you must either be paid in full or on a payment plan. If you are on a payment plan and fail to meet your deadline for payment, you will be given a one week grace period. If at the end of this period you still fail to pay, your program will be stopped until you become current again.

Your single biggest responsibility as a new member is maintaining above average scholastic standing. Without school this fraternity could not exist. A 2.5 GPA must be attained for consideration of initiation. Without the 2.5 there is nothing that we can do.
