Winter Break Reminders 2009



1. The Village Apartments will remain open during Winter break.
2. There will be a 24-hour quiet hours in all buildings during finals week, beginning at 11:59 p.m. November 14th. The 24-hour quiet hours will end Saturday, November 21st at 9:00 a.m. Regular quiet hours will be observed during the break.
3. All apartment residents leaving for the break should adhere to the following security and safety considerations:
 - a. All trash removed from the apartment and placed into the dumpsters.
 - b. Refrigerators should be emptied of all perishable items and defrosted. Please do not use a sharp object to remove ice from the freezer walls, ceiling and bottom. The refrigerant is in the small tubes within the thin walls. If punctured the refrigerator is not repairable. Refrigerators should be left plugged in and running.
 - c. All small appliances (coffee pots, hair dryers, curling irons, toasters, etc.) should be unplugged, windows/blinds closed, lights, stove/oven turned off, heat lowered to 60 degrees.
 - d. To insure survival all fish and plants they should be taken home. To help deter any break-ins please take all valuables: TVs, stereos, computers and CDs home.
 - e. Remember to pay your Winter Quarter bills over the break. Check your bill statement for the due dates. Outstanding bills may cause a hold to be placed on your records or your classes dropped. Questions call Bursar Office 775-5650.
 - f. Lock all the windows, pull blinds shut, and lock the front door upon departure.
4. Housing and maintenance staff will be entering all rooms during the break for the purpose of completing preventative maintenance and outstanding work orders from the August check-outs. Please call in maintenance requests to x4141.
5. The University will be closed November 11th, 26th, 27th, December 24th, 25th, and January 1st.
