Admission Requirement to this major at Wright State:

1. 24 hours earned;
2. Cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher;
3. Grade of C or higher in ENG 111 and 112;
4. Grade of C or higher in MTH 128, 129, or in a higher level math course;
5. Completion of 3 general education courses from Humanities and/or Social and Behavioral Science.

Additional Information:

All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State must complete 60 hours of courses at the 300- and 400-levels. The state of Ohio requires courses to be counted at the level they were completed; therefore, lower-level transfer courses used in substitution for upper-level courses will not count toward this 60-hour requirement.
