4. Grade of C or higher in ENG 111, 112, STT 264, PSY 111, 112, CHM 116, BIO 121, 122, 123, 131, and SOC 110;
5. Submit a College of Nursing and Health admission application by the established deadlines (available at [http://www.wright.edu/nursing/prog\\_info/bsn.html](http://www.wright.edu/nursing/prog_info/bsn.html));
6. Submit a written statement of 250 words or less describing life experience the applicant brings to nursing.
