**What is Organizational Leadership?**

Organizational Leadership is a B.S. degree completion program in a leadership-focused, multidisciplinary, application-oriented major. It is designed for students with a two-year degree, or its equivalent, who want a broad academic background to prepare students for a broad spectrum of careers where leadership skills are important. The major combines courses in communications, leadership, psychology, and management with the study and application of leadership theory to practice. Students will gain foundations in leadership, including training and development, contemporary issues, and leadership assessment. Additionally, students will learn problem problem-solving techniques and complete a leadership application capstone project. This integrated major prepares today's and tomorrow's leaders for the challenge across all career fields.

**Why major in Organizational Leadership?**

Today we see a surging interest in the demand for graduates with leadership understanding and skills. With the rapid rate of change in our global economy, people in supervisory positions must be more adaptive and innovative than ever before. They must learn to **lead!**
