Admission Requirement to this major at Wright State:

1. 45 hours earned;
2. Cumulative GPA of 2.25 or higher;
3. Grade of C or higher in ENG 111 and 112;
4. Grade of C or higher in SWK 100 and 131 (or SWK 130 & 271);
4. Completion of SOC 110, PLS 130, ECO 110, PSY 111, PSY 223, COM 111 (or SWK 136), BIO 142, SWK 100, and SWK 131 (or SWK 130 & 271);
5. Completion of SW 272 at WSU with grade of C or higher;
6. Completion of the official application to the Social Work program.

Admission to the Social Work program is competitive. Meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee admission to the major.

Additional Information:

All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State must complete 60 hours of courses at the 300- and 400-levels. The state of Ohio requires courses to be counted at the level they were completed; therefore, lower-level transfer courses used in substitution for upper-level courses will not count toward this 60-hour requirement.
