Admission Requirement to this major at Wright State:

1. 45 quarter/30 semester hours earned;
2. Cumulative GPA of 2.5;
3. Grade of C or better in ENG 121S, 122S;
4. Completion of three general education courses in Social Science and/or Humanities.

Additional Information:

All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State must complete 60 quarter hours of courses at the 300- and 400-levels. The state of Ohio requires courses to be counted at the level they were completed; therefore, lower-level transfer courses used in substitute for upper-level courses will not count toward this 60 quarter hour requirement.
