Wright State University Academic Policy on Excelsior College's Credit-by-Examinations

The guidelines that govern the application of transfer credit will be used to apply credit to degree requirements for students who score at or above designated minimums on Excelsior College's Credit-by-Examinations (ECE).

Individual academic departments have determined how ECE credit is to be awarded. If the department has determined that the ECE exam is the equivalent of a specific course, credit will be awarded for that class as shown above. In some instances, a department has determined that the ECE exam does not cover the equivalent content of a single course, but will award "general elective" credit according to the recommendations of the American Council on Education (ACE).

The above course equivalencies and credit hours will be awarded only to students whose Excelsior College's Credit-by-Examinations grades have not already been evaluated at Wright State. Course equivalencies and credit hours are subject to change without notice and will be granted in accordance with those current when Excelsior College's Credit-by-Examinations grades are evaluated.
