**Memorandum of Agreement
Wright State University
and
Grand Lake Law Enforcement Academy**

Wright State University agrees to recognize the certificate of completion in Police Officer Basic Training at Grand Lake Law Enforcement Academy and award twenty-one (21) hours of elective credit toward either the Associate of Technical Study (ATS) or the Bachelor of Arts degree in Criminal Justice (CRJ) at Wright State University. Credit will be applied toward the Technical Core Requirements for the ATS degree or applied toward the General Electives requirement for the CRJ degree (see section VI in CRJ section, below).
