53.5 hours of Nursing credit  
Free electives

Students will need to complete general education, additional sciences, and additional Nursing courses in order to meet all requirements for the B.S.N. degree.

**Sinclair students may take any or all of the following courses in order to meet additional requirements toward the B.S.N. degree:**


Sinclair's Transfer Module completes WSU's general education.

Admission Requirement to this major at Wright State:


1. Associate degree in nursing and RN licensure;
2. Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher or in all courses;
3. Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher in all pre-requisites courses;
4. Grade of C or higher in ENG 111, 112; MAT 122 or other statistics courses; PSY 121 & 122 (or 119), CHE 122; BIO 141, 142, 143, & 205; and SOC 111;
5. Submit a College of Nursing and Health admission application by the established deadlines (available at [http://www.wright.edu/nursing/prog\\_info/rn\\_bsn\\_admission.html](http://www.wright.edu/nursing/prog_info/rn_bsn_admission.html)).

**Note: Admission to the B.S.N. in Nursing is competitive.**
