Students may complete ANY associate degree at Sinclair and use all, or almost all, of their credits toward the Bachelor of Science degree in Organizational Leadership at Wright State.

What is Organizational Leadership?

Organizational Leadership is a B.S. degree completion program in a management-focused, multidisciplinary, application-oriented major. It is designed for students with a two-year degree or its equivalent who want a broad academic background to prepare them for supervisory and management careers. The major combines courses in communications and management skills with the study of leadership theory and practice. Students will also learn problem-solving techniques and complete a leadership skills project. This integrated major prepares today's and tomorrow's leaders for the challenge across all career fields.

Why major in Organizational Leadership?

Today we see a surging interest in organizational leadership. With the rapid rate of change in our global economy, people in managerial positions must be more adaptive and innovative than ever before. They must learn to **lead!**

- 3) 2 Organizational Leadership prerequisites (listed above)


