\*Classical Humanities majors need to take Latin or Greek through the cross-registration program.

\*B.S. majors in Urban Affairs and Geography are not required to complete a foreign language.

Admission Requirement to this major at Wright State:

1. 24 hours earned;
2. Cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher, except African & African American Studies requires a 2.5, Modern Language a 2.5, Motion Pictures a 2.25, and Urban Affairs a 2.3;
3. Grade of C or higher in ENG 121S and 122S;
4. Completion of 3 general education courses from Arts & Humanities or Social and Behavioral Science;
5. B.A. Economics majors also need a grade of C or better in MTH 122S or 226S.

Additional Information:

All Liberal Arts B.A. majors at Wright State must complete 60 hours of courses at the 300- and 400-levels. The state of Ohio requires courses to be counted at the level they were completed; therefore, lower-level transfer courses used in substitute for upper-level courses will not count toward this 60 hour requirement.
