First Year Curriculum Guide Intended Major: Athletic Training Prepared by the University College 2009/2010

Welcome to Wright State University!

To remain on track during your first year, you should:

1. Complete an English composition course each quarter with a grade of P, C or better until ENG 102 is completed;
2. Complete a mathematics course each quarter with a grade of P, C or better until STT 160 (GE substitution) is completed;
3. Maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA, including the following courses
 - o ENG 101, 102
 - o Required ATR courses, *if admitted into major!*
 - o HPR 250, 251, BIO 101/BIO 107 & CHM 102,
 - o General education courses; Area III GE required course: PSY 105
4. Earn a minimum of 36 quarter hours;
5. Satisfy all high school deficiencies, if any.
6. ***A student should expect to spend 4 years in the ATR program once they're admitted and they begin to follow ATR course sequence.***

Admission to the ATR major is competitive!

Admission to Wright State University does not guarantee entry into a major program of study. If you have not been accepted into the Athletic Training Education Program (ATEP), you should contact Becky Bower (937-775-3259) immediately. To be considered for admission into the ATEP, you must complete all of the application procedures listed on the website by the March 1st deadline:

Application Process (forms available on website):

1. Completed application form,
2. Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5,
3. Three (3) completed recommendation forms,
4. Typed statement of 250 words,
5. Unofficial high school and college transcripts,
6. Medical history form including HBV records,
7. Proof of current physical,
8. Signed technical standards form,
9. Copy of WSU acceptance letter

Ideally, you would apply by March 1st of your senior year in high school. Your next application deadline would be by March 1st of your first college year (mid winter term). If you are not officially admitted into the College of Education and Human Services and the ATEP before or during spring quarter of your second year at Wright State University, you may need to change your intended major to a degree program you can enter. All students must be officially admitted into a major by the end of the quarter in which they earn 90 credit hours or their academic status will be converted to non-degree.

Courses for First Year Students to consider, who are *not* yet in the ATEP:

Fall term: UVC 101-Learning Community (University College recommended), BIO 101, HED 230, HPR 250, Math course, Composition course (DEV or ENG), PSY 105, CHM 101 (if needed) or CHM 102, General Education course

Winter term: HPR 251, CHM 102, Math course, Composition course, General Education course

Spring term: BIO 101, BIO 107, HPR 212, HED 231, RHB 210, MTH/STT 160 course, Composition course, General Education course

Courses for Students *admitted* in to the ATEP program:

Fall term: ATR 261, ATR 284, BIO 101 & Math course based on Placement, UVC 101-Learning Community (University College recommended)

Winter Term: ATR 262, ATR 286, ATR 302, HPR 250,

Spring Term: ATR 360, ATR 386, HPR 245, HPR 251, BIO 107

CHM 102 is a required prerequisite for ANT 310
