### First Year Curriculum Guide Intended Major: Business Prepared by the University College 2009-2010

Welcome to Wright State University!

To remain on track during your *first year*, you should:

1. Complete an English composition course each quarter with a grade of P, C or better until ENG 102 is completed;
2. Complete a mathematics course each quarter with a grade of P, C or better until MTH 228 is completed;
3. Maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA, including the following courses
  - ENG 101, 102
  - MTH 128, 228
  - CS 205
  - General education courses;
4. Earn a minimum of 36 quarter hours;
5. Satisfy all high school deficiencies, if any.

Admission to Wright State University does not guarantee entry into a major program of study. **To transfer from the University College into the Raj Soin College of Business you must have:**

1. 45 quarter hours earned;
2. 2.5 cumulative GPA from all schools combined;
3. Completed ENG 101 and 102 with a grade of C or better;
4. Completed MTH 128 or 228 with a grade of C or better.

**Ideally, you will enter the Raj Soin College of Business at the end of the quarter in which you earn 45 credit hours, but no later than your fifth quarter at Wright State University.**

#### Additional Information:

- In General Education, you must take MTH 228 instead of MTH 145 and EC 204 and 205 instead of EC 200.
- You must take EC 290 or FIN 205 for your College Component in General Education.

## **FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

### **Why aren't I in a Business/Accounting/etc class this quarter?**

Many classes within the Raj Soin College of Business are restricted until you are admitted to the college, have reached Sophomore status, or have completed pre-requisites. These requirements mean first year students normally will not be in any of these classes.

### **Why can't I take EC 200 instead of EC 204 and 205?**

EC 200 is designed as a general economics class for non-business majors. As such it does not cover the material to the level needed in business.

### **Can I take an "HPR" class, like weight-lifting or basketball?**

You may take up to four (4) hours (2 classes) of HPR 100/101 to count toward Non-Business electives. All business majors, except International Business majors have some non-business electives.

### **Do I need a foreign language?**

If you have a high school deficiency in Foreign Language, you must make up the deficiency. Otherwise, the only business students required to complete foreign language courses are International Business majors.

### **What math classes do I have to take as a business major?**

All business majors complete Math 228, Calculus for Management, Life and Social Sciences. This calculus is not as rigorous as the sequence of calculus for other majors like engineering and math majors. It is important for you to take math during your freshman year and continue the sequence until you complete Math 228.
