First Year Curriculum Guide Intended Major: Theatre (Acting; Acting/Musical Theatre; Dance; Design Technology; Motion Picture Production; Theatre Studies) Prepared by the University College 2009-2010

Welcome to Wright State University!

To remain on track during your first year, you should:

1. Complete required Theatre, Dance and Motion Picture courses;
2. Maintain a 2.0 cumulative GPA (or 2.25 for Motion Picture Production), including the following courses
 - Theatre, Dance and Motion Pictures courses
 - ENG 101, 102, if possible
 - General education courses, if possible;
3. Earn a minimum of 36 quarter hours;
4. Satisfy all high school deficiencies, if any.
5. Complete requirements for admission to the Theatre department within 3 quarters.

Admission to Wright State University does not guarantee entry into a major program of study. To transfer from the University College into the College of Liberal Arts you must have:

For Acting, Musical Theatre, Design Technology and Dance

1. 24 quarter hours earned;
2. 2.0 cumulative GPA.

For B.F.A. Motion Pictures majors must have:

1. 24 quarter hours earned;
2. 2.25 cumulative GPA;
3. Completed MP 131 and 180 with a grade of B or better.

For Theatre Studies and B.A. Motion Pictures majors must also have:

1. 24 quarter hours earned;
2. 2.0 cumulative GPA;
3. ENG 101 and 102 with a grade of C or better;
4. Completed 3 general education courses from Areas II, III and IV.

Ideally, you will enter the College of Liberal Arts at the end of the quarter in which you earn 24 credit hours (or 36 hours for Motion Pictures majors), but no later than your third quarter.

You must be admitted to a major by the end of the quarter in which you earn 90 credit hours, or you will be converted to non-degree status.

Additional Information:

- Acting, Dance and Musical Theatre students must successfully audition in order to take major-related courses.
- Motion Picture majors must meet additional requirements to continue in the BFA program.
- You must take TH 214 in General Education (except Motion Picture majors may choose ART 214 instead).
- Acting, Design Technology, Musical Theatre and Theatre Studies majors must take TH 250 for College Component in General Education.
